How they can help:

Property Platform

We have a Property Platform to help you find student housing in London. You can search accommodation provided by private landlords, letting agents, private halls and other providers of private housing. All providers are checked by us before they sign up, and must also agree to our code of practice, so you can feel confident in your search. Contract checking

We can check the contract for unfair terms which may cause you problems in your accommodation. We can also check that any letting agent you are renting with has the right accreditations. You can contact us to book an appointment for this service, or use our <u>Contract Checking Guide</u>.
