

## **Confetti Media Group – Privacy Notice – For Alumni**

### **Introduction**

Confetti College (part of Nottingham Trent University) is committed to protecting the privacy and security of your personal information and strictly adhere to the rules laid out by the UK General Data Protection Regulation (UK GDPR), Data Protection Act of 2018 and Data Use and Access Act of 2025. This Privacy Notice provides important information about how Confetti College (CC) and its associated entities (“Confetti”, “we”, or “us”), which includes Nova Centric Ltd; and Nottingham Trent University (“NTU”), identifies and manages its Data Protection responsibilities in accordance with its legal and regulatory obligations. CC is wholly owned by NTU, and as such NTU’s Privacy Notice has been adopted, with additions to reflect local business practice.

Confetti encourage you to review the privacy statements of any websites you choose to navigate to from our website (or navigate from to our website) or digital services that we provide links to, so that you can understand how those websites collect, use and share your information as well. Any third-party sites that you can access through the website are not covered by this Privacy Notice and we accept no responsibility or liability for these sites.

### **Who we are**

Confetti is a “data controller” which means we are responsible for deciding how we hold and use personal information about you.

This Privacy Notice applies to all Confetti alumni, supporters and friends (“you” or “your”) or services that link to it (collectively, our “Services”). Occasionally, a Service will link to a different Privacy Statement that will outline the particular privacy practices of that Service (e.g. Access Creative, for further education students; website and cookies).

### **Personal information**

Confetti is committed to the responsible handling and protection of personal information. Personal Data, or personal information, means any information about an individual from which that person (a “Data Subject”) can be identified. It does not include data where the identity has been removed (anonymous data). The information will be Personal Data if a person can be identified either directly or indirectly, in particular by reference to an identifier such as a name, an identification number, location data, an online identifier or to one or more factors specific to the physical, physiological, genetic, mental, economic,

cultural or social identity of that person. For example, personal data may include names, addresses, email addresses and telephone numbers; it may also include images in photographs or films and recorded telephone conversations.

### **Why we process your data**

We collect, use, disclose, transfer, and store personal information to provide services to you and for our operational and business purposes as described in this Privacy Notice. We will always ensure that such processing is based on a lawful basis under the UK GDPR (such as consent, contract, legal obligation, legitimate interests, or tasks carried out in the public interest).

### **How we keep your data secure in other countries**

Your personal information may be transferred by us or our trusted partners outside of the UK or the European Economic Area (the "EEA").

Where your personal information is transferred outside the UK, we will ensure it is appropriately protected, for example by using the UK's International Data Transfer Agreement (IDTA) or the UK Addendum to the EU Standard Contractual Clauses, or other safeguards approved by the ICO.

This means your rights and protections remain with your data, even where it is transferred internationally.

### **Your rights**

You have the following rights under the UK GDPR:

- **Right of access** – to request a copy of the personal data we hold about you.
- **Right to rectification** – to ask us to correct incomplete or inaccurate information.
- **Right to erasure** – to request deletion of your personal data where no lawful basis exists for continued processing.
- **Right to object** – to object to processing based on legitimate interests, including direct marketing.
- **Right to restrict processing** – in certain circumstances.
- **Right to data portability** – to receive your data in a usable format and transfer it to another controller where processing is based on consent or contract.
- **Right to withdraw consent** – where processing is based on consent, you may withdraw it at any time.
- **Right not to be subject to automated decision-making** producing legal or similarly significant effects.
