During the coming week I shall have much pleasure in calling on you in Versailles with Señora Ortiz.

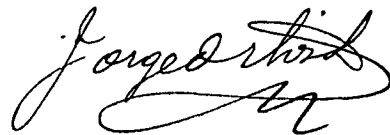
