Dear Parents and Carers,

Please ensure your child is booked into club, or on the bus, by 23:59 the night before without exception. Please remember to cancel any bookings no longer needed. Missed bookings, or bookings called through to the office after this time, will be subject to an additional £12 charge. Thank you for your cooperation.

*To book clubs (including the bus), please login to ParentPay, click the menu icon (on the top left ) , select Payer Dashboard, select your child's name, select Clubs, then select the individual clubs you wish to book.

Going forwards a light tea will be provided for those children in after school club between 5pm – 5.30pm. This may include crumpets, toast, pasta and crudités, and the children can get involved in preparing it if they wish to.

For after school activity clubs, we can only accept bookings for the full block, not for individual sessions. Raffles Forest School

What is Forest School?

It's not just playing outdoors with sticks... well it is... but is also a way of learning about the natural world. Children learn to use tools to make toys and shelters... using only the natural materials they can find. Children learn new skills, such as knots and knife skills, making campfires and basic cooking skills. Children explore the natural environment and habitats, investigate animal life, insects, plants and trees. They are allowed to get mucky and have fun... all in a safe and friendly woodland!

Forest School allows time for play, exploration, curiosity and choices. It removes targets and timelines, encouraging creativity and independence. Learning new and valuable skills, children can then take these experiences and skills and apply them in their formal education.

Most importantly, Forest School bolsters self-esteem, promoting a sense of self-belief in your child's own inherent strengths.

Get the kids outside after school for some fresh air where they can explore, learn to use traditional hand tools, natural materials & their imaginations to have fun, create & learn about nature. Or they can create their own fun bug hunting, den building.... the possibilities are endless!
