Use language to imagine and recreate roles and experiences in play situations. Represent own ideas, thoughts & feelings through role play & stories. Sequence pictures to retell a story. Say, read and begin to write the phonemes / graphemes, e.g. /s/. Begin to segment and blend. Practice blending and reading high frequency words.

Home learning idea: Video your child retelling a favourite story.

PSED

Reflect on what makes them special. Talk about the people who are important to them. Think who they can go to if they need help. Learn about things that make us the same or different from each other and celebrate differences. Reflect on kindness as a way of helping people feel good.

Home learning idea: Talk together about small things we can do everyday to show kindness- like kind words, being helpful around the home sharing things etc.

Topic

Know that people have similarities and differences. Talk about what makes themselves special. Talk about the people in their family and understand that families are all different.

Home learning idea: Ask your child to make a scrap book/memory box containing all things that are special to them.

Move safely in a space. Follow instructions and stop safely. Handle tools, objects, construction and malleable materials safely and with increasing control.

Home learning idea: Challenge your child to independently get dressed and undressed.

Maths

Matching and sorting. Comparing size, mass and capacity. Comparing amounts. Exploring patterns. Subitising (looking at small sets of objects and instantly knowing how many are there without counting) Representing 1, 2 & 3.

Home learning idea: Give your child some socks and ask them to pair them up.

Value - Thankfulness

Home learning idea: What is your child thankful for? Ask them to draw a picture or take a photo of this item.

R.E

Explore what it means to belong. Know ways in which people show belonging to different groups, including religious ones. Find out how babies are welcomed into different groups. Observe ceremonies which show belonging. *Home learning idea: Draw a picture or draw a picture of your family.*
