French at Sapperton is inclusive. Each lesson provides opportunities for all children work at their own pace to consolidate and apply their learning.

How We Support Children with SEND in French

French lessons are planned so that all children can take part and succeed. Support includes:

- Clear, child-friendly explanations of learning
- Consistent routines and a calm learning environment
- Visual supports such as pictures and symbols
- Practical activities, stories and role play
- Time to pre-teach, revisit and reinforce key ideas
- Working walls with key information displayed
- Peer support through mixed groupings
- Use of songs and listening opportunities

Adaptations and Additional Support

Where needed, children with SEND may receive:

- Simplified language and instructions
- Different text formats to support reading
- Learning broken into small steps
- Pre-teaching of key vocabulary
- Alternative ways to share ideas (talking, drawing or using technology)
- Additional adult support
- Personalised word mats
- Sentence starters acting as scaffolds

All adaptations are based on individual needs and maintain high expectations for every child.
