Dear Year 4 Parents,

As I am sure you are aware, internet safety of children across the UK has been in the news recently and continues to be a concern. We know that the best protection we can give to young people is knowledge of the dangers so that they are aware and can protect themselves, as well as letting them know where they can go for help and support with regards to Cyber Bullying.

Our Year 4 children have been offered an opportunity to attend an interactive play which will tackle some of the issues around Safe Internet Use, Cyber Bullying and prevention of exploitation. The play is age appropriate and is called 'In the Net'. It will last for approximately 50 minutes, and pupils will be provided with a support pack at the end of the production. This activity is part of a programme of work around raising and tackling the complex nature of Internet Use and is being supported by the Education and Learning Sub Group of the Gloucestershire Safeguarding Children Partnership (GSCP).

We hope that this will be a memorable way to enhance their safe internet usage and help our young people to stay safe on-line.

The play is being presented on **Friday 6th March 2026 at Nailsworth Primary School and starts at 10am**. The performance is free to attend, but we would very much appreciate your support in transporting the children to and from Nailsworth Primary School. The children will need to be collected from Sapperton School at 9.30am and then be brought back at 10:50am from Nailsworth Primary School. There will be a member of staff from Sapperton present to greet the children on arrival at Nailsworth Primary School and help to organize them upon departure.
