PATTERN MARKINGS

**GRAINLINE:** Place on straight grain of fabric, parallel to selvage or fold.**FOLDLINE:** Place line on fold of fabric.**BUTTONHOLE MARKING:** Indicates exact length and placement of buttonholes.**BUTTON MARKING:** Indicates button placement.**NOTCHES AND SYMBOLS:** For matching seams and construction details.

Indicates the Bustline, Waistline, Hip and/or Biceps. Measurements refer to circumference of Finished Garment (Body Measurement + Wearing Ease + Design Ease). Adjust pattern if necessary. The measurement excludes pleats, tucks, darts and seam allowances.

SEAM ALLOWANCE: 5/8" (1.5cm) included unless otherwise indicated, but not printed on tissue.

ADJUST IF NECESSARY

Lengthen or Shorten at adjustment lines (==) or where indicated on pattern. If substantial length is added, you may need to purchase additional fabric.

TO SHORTEN: Crease along adjustment line. Make a fold half the amount needed. Tape in place.**TO LENGTHEN:** Slash between adjustment lines. Spread amount as needed, keeping edges parallel. Tape over paper.

When Alteration lines are not on tissue, lengthen or shorten at lower edge.

SHRINK FABRIC if not labeled pre-shrunk. Press.**CIRCLE LAYOUT** for View, Size, Fabric Width.Use **WITH NAP** layout for fabrics with one-way designs, nap, pile or surface shading. Because most knits have surface shading, a with nap layout is used.**FOR DOUBLE THICKNESS (WITH FOLD)** - fold fabric with right sides together.*** FOR DOUBLE THICKNESS (WITHOUT FOLD)** - For fabrics with nap, fold fabric crosswise, right sides together. Mark as shown. Cut along crosswise fold of fabric (A). Turn upper layer 180° so arrows go in same direction and place over lower layer, right sides together (B).For **SINGLE THICKNESS** - place fabric right side up. (For Fur Pile fabrics, place pile side down.)





CUTTING AND MARKING

★ Cut other pieces first, allowing enough fabric to cut this piece. Open fabric. For "Cut 1" pieces, cut piece once on single layer of fabric with piece face up on right side of fabric.


Pattern may have cutting lines for several sizes. Select the proper cutting line or pattern pieces for your size.

Before **CUTTING** place all pieces on fabric according to layout. Pin. (Layouts show approximate position of pattern pieces; position may vary according to your pattern size.) Cut **ACCURATELY**, cutting notches outward.Before removing pattern, **TRANSFER MARKINGS** and lines of construction to Wrong Side of fabric, using the Pin and Chalk Pencil method or Tracing Paper and Dressmaker Wheel. Markings needed on right side of fabric should be thread traced.**NOTE:** Broken-line boxes (al bl cl) in layouts represent pieces cut by measurements provided.



SEAM ALLOWANCES

Use 1/4" (6mm) seam allowances unless otherwise indicated.



PIN AND FIT

Pin or baste seams, RIGHT SIDE TOGETHER, matching notches. Fit garment before stitching major seams.

PRESS

Press seam allowances flat; then open unless otherwise stated. Clip where necessary so they lie flat.



GLOSSARY OF SEWING METHODS

Sewing procedures **BOLD/ITALICIZED** in Sewing Directions are defined below.


SLIPSTITCH - Slide needle through a folded edge, then pick up a thread of underneath fabric.

LADDER STITCH - Using a strong thread, take a small stitch in one edge close to seam. Then take a small stitch in the other edge close to seam. Pull up thread after each stitch to bring edges together. Continue to alternate from edge to edge with the smallest hand stitches possible. Knot thread securely at end of stitching.




STUFF - Pull fiberfill apart and fluff it before you use it. Break apart lumps and thick spots. Use pieces about the size of a tennis ball for large areas. For small areas, use pieces the size of a ping pong ball or smaller. Pack into place using the end of a long handled wooden spoon or chopstick. Pack firmly in place each time stuffing is added, unless otherwise directed in Sewing Instructions. Use both hands to mold and shape, being careful not to over stuff or make lopsided. When stuffing sections that will be inserted into seams, place less stuffing at opening seam line so that you will be able to stitch through it.

All seam allowances are 1/4" (6mm), unless otherwise indicated. Press seams open unless otherwise indicated, clipping as necessary.




GENERAL DIRECTIONS FOR APPLIQUE

PREPARE - Fuse paper back fusible web to **WRONG** side of applique fabric following manufacturer's instructions. Pin pattern to **RIGHT** side of prepared fabric. Cut out each applique. Transfer markings to **RIGHT** side of applique using a washable fabric marking pen or pencil.

APPLY - Remove paper backing from applique. Pin applique(s) to item within placement lines as instructed in sewing directions. Fuse in place following manufacturer's instructions. Zig-zag (satin) stitch along raw edges.

EMBROIDERY STITCHES

NOTE: Use embroidery floss in a contrasting color for all embroidery stitches and knot one end.


PATTERN PIECES WILL BE IDENTIFIED BY NUMBERS THE FIRST TIME THEY ARE USED. STITCH SEAMS WITH RIGHT SIDES TOGETHER UNLESS OTHERWISE STATED.

Seam allowance is 1/4" (6mm) unless otherwise stated.


BEAR A

BODY FRONT APPLIQUE

1. PREPARE INNER EAR, MUZZLE AND BELLY APPLIQUE (2). With **RIGHT** sides up, **APPLY** belly to **BODY FRONT** (1) centered within placement line. **APPLY** muzzle to body front centering within placement line.



2. PREPARE NOSE APPLIQUE (3). **APPLY** nose to muzzle along placement line. Attach safety eyes to small dots on face, following manufacturer's directions.



3. Embroider muzzle along solid line below nose using a RUNNING STITCH. Make a FRENCH KNOT at lower end.



EARS

4. For each ear, with **RIGHT** sides up, **APPLY** Inner Ear applique to **EAR** (4), within placement line. (Remaining ear sections will be used as facing.)



5. Pin ear **FACING** (4) to ear, matching dots. Stitch curved edge



6. Turn **RIGHT** side out; baste raw edges.




7. On outside, with inner ear side down, pin ears to upper edge of body front, matching small dots, having raw edges even. Baste, clipping ears as necessary.




ARMS

8. With **RIGHT** sides together, fold **ARM** (5) along lower fold line, having long edges even. Stitch long edges to dot on curved edge. Clip lower edge to small dot.



9. Turn arm **RIGHT** side out, folding upper edge along fold lines with small and large dots.




10. **STUFF** hand section of arm with Polyfil. Baste raw edges together.



11. Tie a knot on arm above curved edge.




12. With seam facing body, pin arms to body front, matching small and large dots, having raw edges even; baste.




LEGS


13. With **RIGHT** sides together, fold **LEG** (6) along lower fold line, having long edges even. Stitch long edges to dot on curved edge. Clip inward corner and lower edge to small dot.



14. Turn leg **RIGHT** side out, folding upper edge along fold lines with small and large dots.




15. **STUFF** foot section of leg with Polyfil. Baste raw edges together.



16. Tie a knot on leg above curved edge.




17. With seam facing body, pin legs to lower edge of body front, matching small and large dots, having raw edges even; baste.



BODY BACK


18. Stitch dart seam on **BODY BACK** (7). Slash fold of dart to 1/2" (1.3cm) from point of stitching. Press dart open and point flat.




19. With **RIGHT** sides together, pin body back sections, matching notches and dots. Stitch center back seam, leaving free between dots for turning and stuffing. Clip curve.




20. With **RIGHT** sides together, pin body back to body front, matching centers and small dots, having raw edges even. Stitch; clip curve. Turn body **RIGHT** side out.



21. **STUFF** body firmly with fiberfill.




22. Close opening using a **LADDER STITCH**.

BODY FRONT APPLIQUE


1. To separate **MOUTH AND BELLY APPLIQUE** and **INNER EYE** (9), cut along solid line. **PREPARE MOUTH AND BELLY APPLIQUE.** Cut out inner eye shapes and set aside.



2. **APPLY** mouth and belly appliques to **BODY FRONT** (8) within placement lines.



3. Thread needle with embroidery floss. Embroider mouth on body front using a **BACK STITCH**.



EYES

4. **PREPARE PUPIL APPLIQUE** (11). **APPLY** pupil to RIGHT side of inner eye.



5. With right sides together, pin **EYE** (10) to inner eye/pupil, matching dots. Stitch curved edge.



6. Turn **RIGHT** side out; baste raw edges.




7. On outside, with eye side down, pin eye to upper edge of body front, matching small dots, having raw edges even. Baste.




ARMS

8. With **RIGHT** sides together, fold **ARM** (12) along lower fold line, having long edges even. Stitch long edges to dot on curved edge. Clip curve. Trim corners. Clip lower edge to small dot.



9. Turn arm **RIGHT** side out, folding upper edge along fold lines with small and large dots.



10. **STUFF** hand section of arm with Polyfil. Baste raw edges together.




11. Stitch hand section along stitching lines.



12. Tie a knot on arm above curved edge.




13. With seam facing body, pin arms to body front, matching small and large dots, having raw edges even; baste.



LEGS

14. With **RIGHT** sides together, fold **LEG** (13) along lower fold line, having long edges even. Stitch long edges. Clip to inward corner. Trim corners.



15. Turn leg **RIGHT** side out, folding upper edge along fold lines with small and large dots.



16. **STUFF** foot section of leg with Polyfil. Baste raw edges together.



17. Stitch foot section along stitching lines.



18. Tie a knot on leg above curved edge.




19. With seam facing body, pin legs to lower edge of body front, matching small and large dots, having raw edges even; baste.



BODY BACK


20. Complete frog following **BEAR A; BODY BACK** steps 18-22.



MONKEY C

BODY FRONT APPLIQUE

1. **PREPARE INNER EAR, FACE AND CHEST APPLIQUE** (15). **APPLY** face and chest appliques to **BODY FRONT** (14). Set aside inner ear appliques.



2. Thread needle with embroidery floss. Embroider mouth on face along solid line using a **BACK STITCH**.



3. Attach safety eyes to upper small dots on face, following manufacturer's directions.



EARS

4. **APPLY** inner ear (15) appliques to **RIGHT** side of two **EAR** (16). (Remaining ear sections will be used as facing.)




5. With **RIGHT** sides together, pin ear **FACING** (16) to ear, matching dots. Stitch curved edge.



6. Turn **RIGHT** side out; baste raw edges.



7. On **OUTSIDE**, with inner ear side down, pin ears to upper edge of body front, matching small and large dots, having raw edges even, clipping ears as necessary. Baste.



ARMS


Prepare **ARM** (5) sections and apply to body front in the same manner as described for **BEAR A; ARMS**, steps 8-12.

LEGS

Prepare **LEG** (6) sections and apply to body front in the same manner as described for **BEAR A; LEGS**, steps 13-17.

BODY BACK


8. Stitch dart seam on **BODY BACK** (18). Slash fold of dart to 1/2" (1.3cm) from point of stitching. Press dart open and point flat.




9. With **RIGHT** sides together, fold **TAIL** (17) in half lengthwise, matching small dots, having long edges even. Stitch long edges. Clip to inward corner.




10. Turn tail **RIGHT** side out.



11. **STUFF** tail with Polyfil. Baste raw edges together, matching small dots.



12. Pin tail to center back seam in one body back section, matching small and large dots, having raw edges even; baste.




13. With **RIGHT** sides together, pin body back sections, matching notches and dots. Stitch center back seam, leaving free between small dots for turning and stuffing. Clip curves.



14. With **RIGHT** sides together, pin body back to body front, matching centers and dots, having raw edges even. Stitch; clip curves.




15. Turn body **RIGHT** side out.




16. **STUFF** body firmly with fiberfill.



17. Close opening using a **LADDER STITCH**.**COW D****BODY FRONT APPLIQUE**


1. **PREPARE MUZZLE AND SPOTS APPLIQUE** (20). Cut out muzzle along solid lines for opening. **APPLY** muzzle and spots to **RIGHT** side of **BODY FRONT** (19).



2. Embroider mouth along solid line below muzzle, using a running stitch. Attach safety eyes to small dots on face on body front, following manufacturer's directions.

**HORNS**

3. Cut out **INNER EAR**, **HORN** AND **TAIL** (21) from contrast fabric remnant. Transfer markings.



4. With **RIGHT** sides together, fold each **HORN** section in half lengthwise, matching large dots. Stitch curved edge.



5. Turn **RIGHT** side out; baste raw edges, matching dots.



6. On outside, pin horns to top of head on body front, matching small and large dots, having raw edges even, clipping horns if necessary. Baste.

**EARS**

7. With **RIGHT** sides together, pin **Inner Ear** (21) to **OUTER EAR** (22), matching small and large dots. Stitch curved edge.




8. Turn **RIGHT** side out; baste raw edges.




9. Fold outer ear along fold line toward inner ear; baste raw edges.




10. On **OUTSIDE**, with inner ear side down, pin ears to upper side edge of body front, matching small and large dots, having raw edges even, clipping ears as necessary. Baste.

**ARMS**


11. With **RIGHT** sides together, fold **ARM** (23) along lower fold line, having long edges even. Stitch long edges to dot on curved edge. Clip curves and lower edge to small dot.




12. Turn arm **RIGHT** side out, folding upper edge along fold lines with small and large dots.



13. Stitch hoof section along stitching line.




14. **STUFF** lower section of arm with Polyfil. Baste raw edges together.



15. Tie a knot on arm above curved edge.



16. With seam facing body, pin arms to body front, matching small and large dots, having raw edges even; baste, clipping arm where necessary.

**LEGS**

17. With **RIGHT** sides together, fold **LEG** (24) along lower fold line, having long edges even. Stitch long edges. Clip to inward corners.




18. Turn leg **RIGHT** side out, folding upper edge along fold lines with small and large dots. Stitch hoof section along stitching line.




19. **STUFF** hoof section of leg with Polyfil. Baste raw edges together.




20. Tie a knot on leg above curved edge.



21. With seam facing body, pin legs to lower edge of body front, matching small and large dots, having raw edges even; baste, clipping leg where necessary.

**BODY BACK**


22. Stitch dart seam on **BODY BACK** (18). Slash fold of dart to 1/2" (1.3cm) from point of stitching. Press dart open and point flat.



23. With **RIGHT** sides together, fold **Tail** (21) in half lengthwise, matching small dots, having long edges even. Stitch long edges.




24. Turn tail **RIGHT** side out. To fringe lower edge of tail, slash along solid lines at lower edge.



25. Pin tail to center back seam in one body back section, matching small and large dots, having raw edges even; baste.





26. With **RIGHT** sides together, pin body back sections, matching notches and dots. Stitch center back seam, leaving free between small dots for turning and stuffing. Clip curves.




27. With **RIGHT** sides together, pin body back to body front, matching centers and dots, having raw edges even. Stitch; clip curves.



28. Turn body **RIGHT** side out. **STUFF** body firmly with fiberfill.



29. Close opening using a **LADDER STITCH**.
