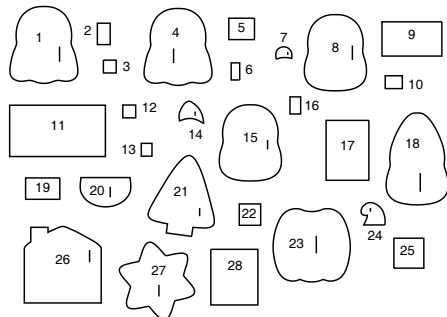

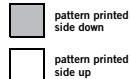

## Cutting Layouts



POSITION OF PATTERN PIECES MAY VARY SLIGHTLY ACCORDING TO YOUR PATTERN SIZE

### General Directions For Cutting

- PRE-SHRINK** and iron all fabric.
- FOR DOUBLE THICKNESS** -Fold fabric with RIGHT sides together. Pin pattern to WRONG side of fabric.
- FOR SINGLE THICKNESS** -Pin pattern to RIGHT side of fabric.
- ★ If layout shows a piece extending past fold, cut out all pieces except piece that extends. Open out fabric to single thickness. Cut extending piece on RIGHT side of fabric in position shown.
- ✱ Mark small arrows along both selvages in dicing direction of nap or design. Fold fabric crosswise with RIGHT sides together, and cut along fold. Turn one fabric layer around so arrows on both layers go in the same direction. Place RIGHT sides together.

Scan QR CODE to watch videos:**STAYSTITCH** - See **Machine Stitches**: "how to do stay-stitching" video.**TRIM** - See **Seams**: "how to trim, clip and layer seams" video.**GLOSSARY OF SEWING METHODS**Sewing procedures **BOLD/ITALICIZED** in Sewing Directions are defined below.

**STUFF** – Pull fiberfill apart and fluff it before you use it. Break apart lumps and thick spots. Use pieces about the size of a tennis ball for large areas. For small areas, use pieces the size of a ping pong ball or smaller. Pack into place using the end of a long handled wooden spoon or chopstick. Pack firmly in place each time stuffing is added, unless otherwise directed in Sewing Instructions. Use both hands to mold and shape, being careful not to over stuff or make lopsided. When stuffing sections that will be inserted into seams, place less stuffing at opening seam line so that you will be able to stitch through it.

**LADDER STITCH** – Using a strong thread, take a small stitch in one edge close to seam. Then take a small stitch in the other edge close to seam. Pull up thread after each stitch to bring edges together. Continue to alternate from edge to edge with the smallest hand stitches possible.

Knot thread securely at end of stitching.

**SIMPLY THE BEST TECHNIQUES FOR SEWING FLEECE**

Fleece fabric is strong, hard to puncture or tear and doesn't ravel or get pilly. Since cut edges of fleece fabrics do not ravel, inner edges of seams and hems can be left raw.

When pinning pieces together, use long pins...the kind with bead heads are best because short pins tend to get lost in the fleece.

Use a ball point needle.

When stitching, try using a narrow zig-zag stitches, adjusting the width and length for the type of fleece you are using. Always test first on some scraps and keep for reference.

Sew slowly and carefully the first time you stitch a seam as stitches are hard to remove.

When sewing around shaped areas sew slowly being careful not to stretch the fleece as you feed fabric through your machine.

Finger press or steam press on a low temperature setting using a press cloth.

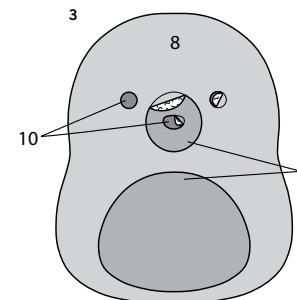
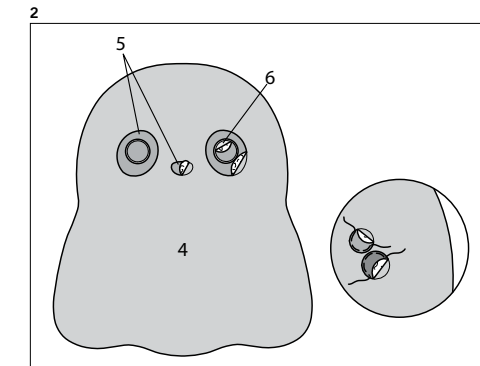
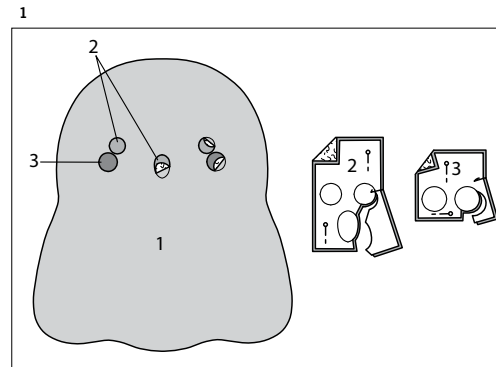
Raw edges can also be cut with pinking shears.

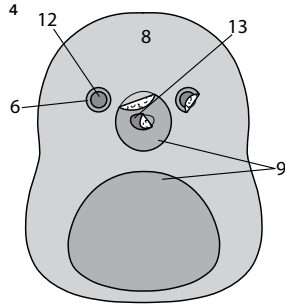
**GENERAL DIRECTIONS FOR APPLIQUES**

**PREPARE** – Fuse paper back fusible web to **WRONG** side of applique fabric following manufacturer's instructions. Pin pattern to **RIGHT** side of prepared fabric. Cut out each applique. Transfer markings to **RIGHT** side of applique using a washable fabric marking pen or pencil.

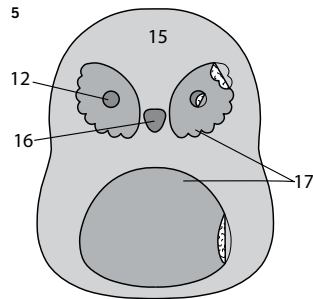
**FUSE** – Remove paper backing from applique. Pin applique(s) to item within placement lines as instructed in sewing directions. Fuse in place following manufacturer's instructions. Straight stitch or zigzag stitch along raw edges.

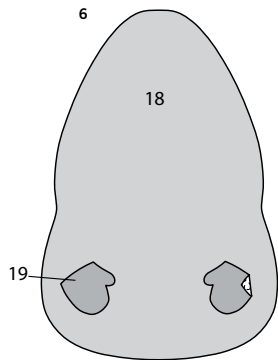

- 4. VIEW D, CAT- PREPARE** BELLY AND MUZZLE APPLIQUE (9), OUTER EYE APPLIQUE (6), EYE APPLIQUE (12), and NOSE APPLIQUE (13).  
For FRONT, **FUSE** belly, and muzzle to RIGHT side of one FRONT AND BACK (8) section within placement lines. **FUSE** outer eyes to front centered over placement line. **FUSE** eyes to outer eye within placement lines. **FUSE** nose to muzzle within placement lines.

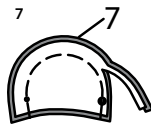


- 5. VIEW E, OWL- PREPARE** BELLY AND EYE PATCH APPLIQUE (17), BEAK APPLIQUE (16), and EYE APPLIQUE (12).  
For FRONT, **FUSE** belly, eye patch, and beak to RIGHT side of one FRONT AND BACK (15) section within placement lines. **FUSE** eyes to eye patch within placement lines.

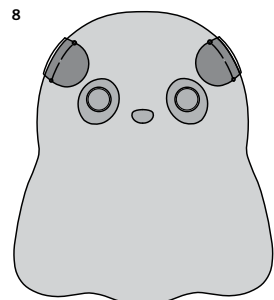


- 6. VIEW F, SANTA- PREPARE** MITTEN APPLIQUE (19). For FRONT, **FUSE** mitten to RIGHT side of one FRONT AND BACK (18) section.

- 7.** For each ear, pin two EAR (7) sections, RIGHT sides together, matching large and small dots, having raw edges even. Stitch outer curved edge leaving open between dots, as shown. **TRIM.**

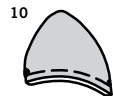


- 8.** Turn RIGHT side out. Press. Baste raw edges together. With RIGHT sides together, pin ears to front matching large and small dots, having raw edges even. Baste.

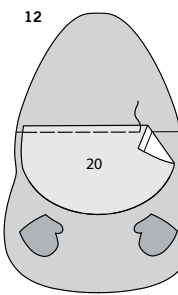
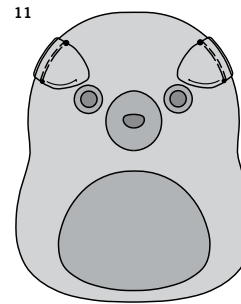

- 9.** For each ear, pin one FELT and one FABRIC EAR (14) section, RIGHT sides together, matching large and small dots, having raw edges even. Stitch outer curved edge leaving open between dots, as shown. **TRIM.**



- 10.** Turn RIGHT side out. Press. Baste raw edges together. **STAYSTITCH** 3/8" (1cm) from raw edge.

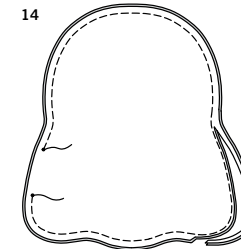
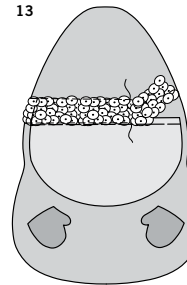


- 11.** With felt side down, pin ears to front matching large and small dots, having raw edges even, clipping ears to staystitching, as needed. Baste.

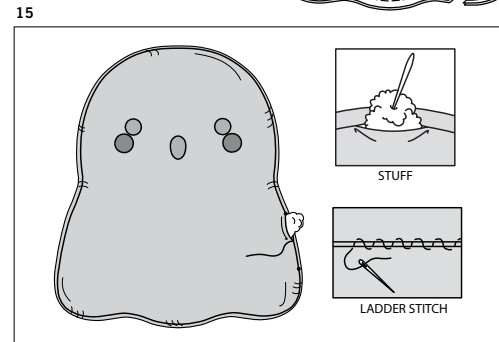
- 12.** Pin WRONG side of BEARD (20) to RIGHT side of front having seamline on beard along placement line. Baste.

- 13.** Pin trim to front having bottom of trim along seamline of beard and ends even with raw edges. Stitch close to long edges of trim. Baste ends.

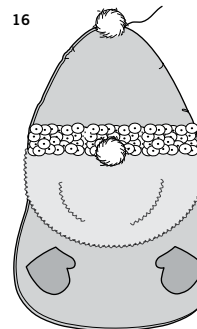

- 14.** Pin front and back sections RIGHT sides together, matching small dots. Stitch leaving open between small dots, as shown. **TRIM.**



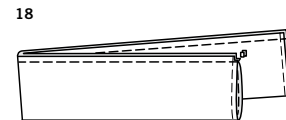
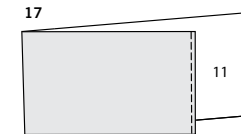
- 15.** Turn RIGHT side out. **STUFF.** Close opening with a **LADDER STITCH.**



- 16. VIEW F:** Sew pompoms to front at large dot on beard and small dot at top of hat.

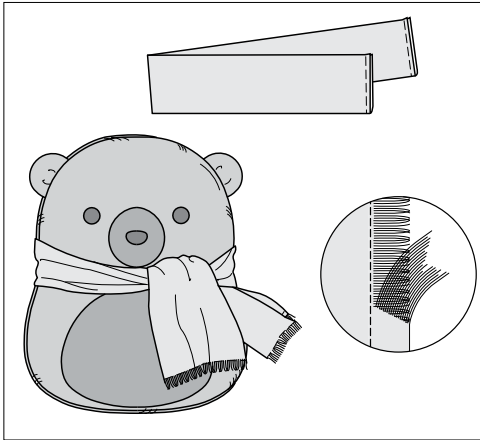

- 17.** Stitch SCARF (11) 1/2" (1.3cm) from ends.



- 18.** Fold scarf in half lengthwise having raw edges even. Stitch long edges ending at stitching on ends. Trim away seam allowances below stitching on ends.

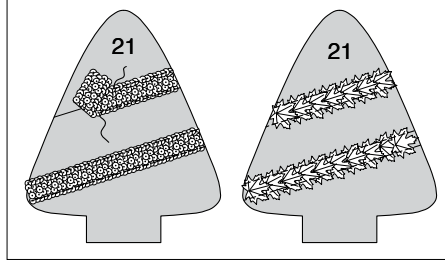

- 19.** Turn. Press. To fringe, remove thread by pulling out fabric thread one at a time up to stitching in the same direction. Wrap scarf around neck of bear.

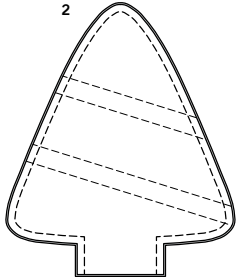

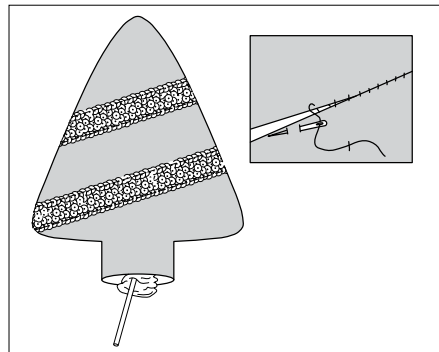
- 1.** For FRONT, pin 2"(5cm) wide trim or leaf embellishments to RIGHT side of one FRONT AND BACK (21), centering over placement lines, as shown. Stitch close to long edges of trim. Stitch through leaves catching in both sides, as shown.

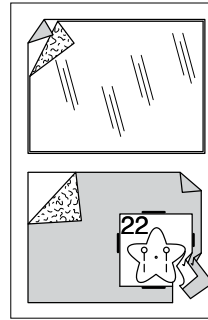
- 2.** Pin front and back sections, RIGHT sides together. Stitch, leaving an open on lower edge. **TRIM.**

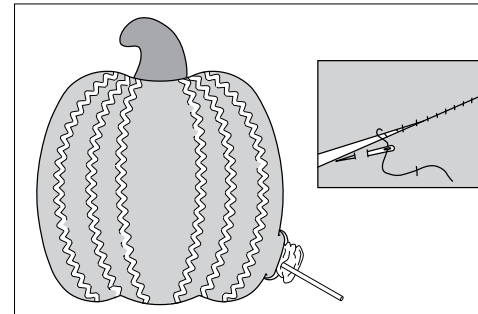
- 1.** **STAYSTITCH** upper edge of FRONT AND BACK (23) between small and large dots. For FRONT, pin rick rack to RIGHT side of one front and back section, centering over placement lines. Stitch through center of rick rack.
- 2.** With RIGHT sides together, pin STEM (24) to front and back section matching small and large dots, clipping pumpkin as needed. Stitch between dots.

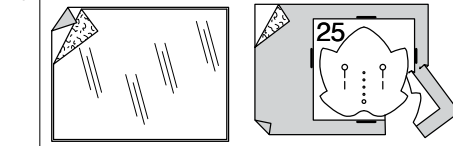
- 3.** Turn up stem. Press. Pin front and back sections, RIGHT sides together, matching small and large dots. Stitch, breaking stitching at small and large dots at stem and leaving open between small dots on side. **TRIM.** Clip inward corners.

- 4.** Turn RIGHT side out. **STUFF.** Close opening with a **LADDER STITCH.**

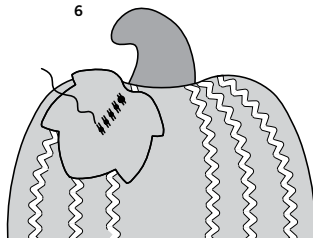

- 5.** Fuse paper back fusible webbing to WRONG side of one LEAF (25) section following manufacturer's directions. Remove paper backing and fuse to WRONG side of remaining leaf section. Pin pattern to right side of prepared fabric and cut out leaf. Transfer markings.

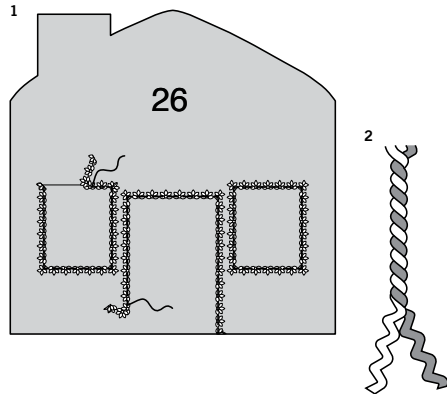

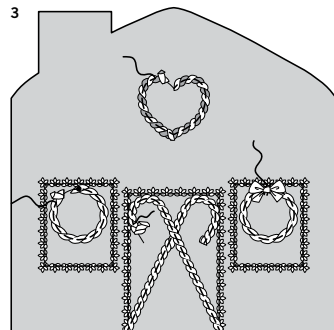

## GINGERBREAD HOUSE I

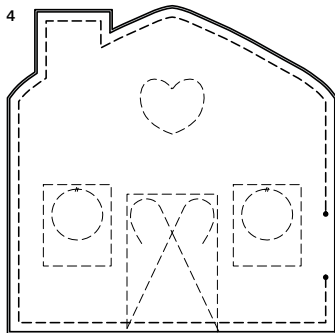


1. For FRONT, create windows by pinning 1/2"(1.3cm) wide flat lace to RIGHT side of one FRONT AND BACK (26), placing straight edge of lace along placement lines, folding in fullness at corners, and turning under one end and lapping over the other. Baste. Stitch close to straight edge of lace. For door, pin lace to front along placement line, folding in corners and having ends even with raw edge. Baste. Stitch close to straight edge of lace.

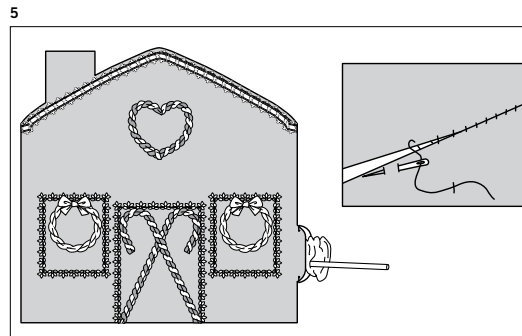
2. To form rick rack trim, cut two equal lengths of rick rack. For heart and each candy cane cut two contrast colors of rick rack, each 15"(38cm) long. For each wreath cut two matching colors of rick rack each 10"(26cm) long. Secure ends of rick rack together at one end. Twist one rick rack trim over the other being careful to keep each strand flat. Finger press the twisted portion as you go. Press flat when complete.



3. Pin trim for heart to front starting at inward corner on upper edge of heart. Center trim over placement line, folding at corner, if necessary. Turn under remaining end of trim and lap over beginning. Cut away excess. Baste. Stitch through center of trim. Turn under one end on one piece of trim for candy cane. Press. Pin trim to front, placing pressed end at upper end of placement line. Center trim over placement line, having remaining end even with raw edge. Baste. Stitch through center of trim. Apply remaining trim to front in same manner, overlapping first candy cane.  
Pin trim for wreath to front, centering along placement lines, turning under one end and lapping over the other. Baste. Stitch through center of trim. Tie ribbons into bow and sew to markings at top of wreaths.

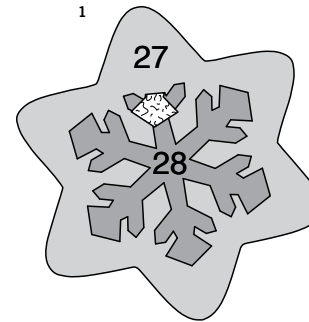


4. Pin front and back sections, RIGHT sides together, having raw edges even. Stitch leaving an opening between small dots. **TRIM.**

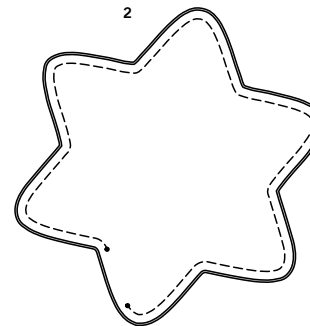


5. Turn RIGHT side out. **STUFF.** Close opening with a **LADDER STITCH.** Pin 2"(5cm) wide flat lace to front of pillow, having straight edge along placement line, turning under ends. Hand sew in place.

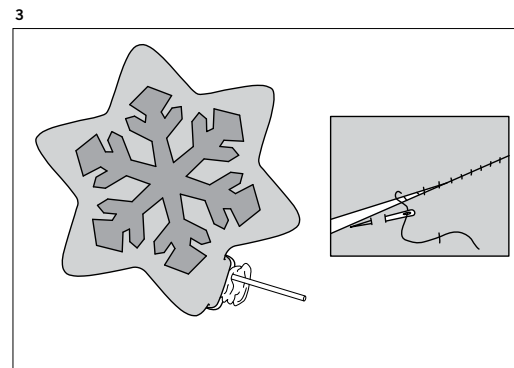
## SNOWFLAKE J



1. PREPARE SNOWFLAKE APPLIQUE (28). For FRONT, **FUSE** snowflake to RIGHT side of one FRONT AND BACK (27) section, matching placement lines.



2. Stitch front and back sections RIGHT sides together, leaving open between small dots. **TRIM.**



3. Turn RIGHT side out. **STUFF.** Close opening with a **LADDER STITCH.**
