(1.2m) of $\frac{1}{2}$ " - $\frac{3}{4}$ " (1.3cm - 2cm) flexible lace. **B:** One pkg. of jumbo rick rack, three %" (1.5cm) novelty buttons. **C:** One pkg. of %" (1.3cm) single fold bias tape, %" (2cm) hook and loop tape: 2" (5cm) length for Children, 3" (8cm) length for Misses, one pkg. of jumbo rick rack (opt.). D: One pkg. of jumbo rick rack (opt.).



Make adjustments before placing

TO LENGTHEN: Cut pattern hetween lengthen or shorten lines. Spread pattern evenly, the amount needed and tape to

paper.

TO SHORTEN: At lengthen or shorten lines. make an even pleat taking up amount needed

When lengthen or shorten lines are not given, make adjustments at lower edge of pattern.

BEFORE CUTTING:

PRESS pattern pieces with a warm dry iron. PRE-SHRINK fabric by pre-washing washables or steam-pressing nonwashables.

CIRCLE your cutting layout.

PIN pattern to fabric as shown in Cutting Layouts.

- . FOR DOLIBLE THICKNESS: Fold fabric with RIGHT sides together.
- . FOR SINGLE THICKNESS: Place fabric RIGHT side up.
- FOR PILE, SHADED OR ONE WAY DESIGN FABRICS: Use "with nap" layouts

AFTER CUTTING:

Transfer markings to WRONG side of fabric before removing pattern. Use pin and chalk method or dressmaker's tracing paper and

To Quick Mark:

- Snip edge of fabric to mark notches, ends of fold lines and center lines.

- . SEW garment following Sewing Directions.
- PIN or machine-baste seams matching notches.
- STITCH 5/8" (1.5 cm) seams unless otherwise stated.
- · PRESS seams open unless otherwise indicated clipping when necessary so seams will lie flat.

REINFORCE - See Machine Stitches: "how to reinforce" video.

SLIPSTITCH – See Hand Stitching: "how to slip stitch" video.

STITCH IN THE DITCH - See Machine Stitches: "how to stitch in the ditch" video.

TACK - See Hand Stitches: "how to tack" video.







- 2. With WRONG sides together, fold NECK TIES (4) in half lengthwise, having raw edges even. Stitch, leaving marked end open TRIM
- Turn RIGHT sides out. Press. Pin neck ties to OUTSIDE of one BIB (3) section, (over trim for View A), matching large and small dots, having raw edges even. Baste.



5. Turn RIGHT side out. Press. Baste raw edges together.

 VIEW B: On OUTSIDE, pin rick rack to bib, centering over placement line, folding in fullness at inward corner. Stitch through center of rick rack.




7. Make a 1/2"(1.3cm) NARROW HEM on curved edge of OVERLAY (2). GATHER upper edge of overlay.




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

 Fuse INTERFACING to WRONG side of WAISTBAND (5) following manufacturer's instructions. Turn under 3/8"(1cm) on upper unnotched edge of waistband. Press.




9. With RIGHT sides together, pin overlay to lower edge of waistband matching center fronts and small dots. Adjust gathers to fit, distributing fullness evenly. Baste.




10. Make a 1/2"(1.3cm) NARROW HEM on side edges of APRON (1). Turn under 1/-1/4"(3.2cm) on lower edge of apron. Turn under 1/4"(6mm) on raw edge of hem. Press. Stitch close to inner pressed edge.


GATHER upper edge of apron.




11. With RIGHT sides together, pin apron to lower edge of waistband, (over WRONG side of overlay), matching notches, center fronts, and side edges of apron to small dots. Adjust gathers. Baste.




12. Pin WRONG side of bib to WRONG side of apron matching center fronts and small dots on waistband. Stitch entire waistband seam. Press seam toward waistband. Do not turn up bib in this step.




13. Fold each TIE END (6) in half lengthwise, RIGHT sides together, having raw edges even. Stitch, leaving marked end open. TRIM.



14. Turn RIGHT side out. Press. Pin tie ends to ends of waistband matching large and small dots. Baste.




15. Fold ends of waistband, RIGHT sides together, over tie ends, matching large and small dots. Stitch ends. **TRIM**.




16. Turn ends RIGHT side out. Press. On INSIDE, with WRONG sides together, pin pressed edge of waistband over seam, placing pins on OUTSIDE.

On OUTSIDE, **STITCH IN DITCH** of seam, catching pressed edge on INSIDE. Press.



17. Turn up bib. TACK side edges of bib to waistband.

VIEW A BOW



19. Turn bow RIGHT side out. Press. SLIPSTITCH opening closed.

20. Fold KNOT (8) in half, lengthwise, RIGHT sides together,



matching notches.
Stitch notched edge.
Turn knot RIGHT side out, bringing seam to center on UNDERSIDE. Press.

21. Crush bow at center and place knot around center of bow, turning under and lapping one end on UNDERSIDE. SLIPSTITCH ends securely catching in UNDERSIDE of bow.

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







- 1. REINFORCE HAT TOP (9) along stitching line. Slash between
- 2. Open out one edge of single fold bias tape. With RIGHT sides together, pin tape to hat top placing crease along stitching line, with ends even with raw edges. Stitch along crease.




3. Turn tape to INSIDE. Press. Baste close to inner edge of tape. On OUTSIDE, stitch as basted.




4. GATHER outer edge of hat top between notches.





5. Fuse INTERFACING to WRONG side of HAT BAND (10), following manufacturer's instructions. Fold hat band along foldline, RIGHT sides together. Stitch ends. TRIM.






7. On OUTSIDE, pin band to hat top matching center fronts, notches, and small dots to opening. Adjust gathers to fit, distributing fullness evenly. Baste. Stitch. Finish seam allowances with a zig zag stitch or by serging. Press seam toward hat.





- 8. Cut a length of 3/4"(2cm) wide hook and loop tape, 2"(5cm) long for children and 3"(8cm) long for adults. Separate tape. On OUTSIDE, pin the rough half of tape to the RIGHT back opening edge. Stitch close to edges of tape. On INSIDE, pin soft half of tape to the LEFT back opening edge. Stitch close to edges of tape.
- 9. OPTIONAL: Pin rick rack to band, 3/4"(2cm) above lower edge, having one end of rick rack at edge of hook side of hook and loop tape and the other end wrap 1/4"(6mm) to inside on opposite opening edge. Stitch through center of rick rack. OPTIONAL BOW: Follow View A, Bow, steps 18 -21. Hand sew how to hat hand where desired






OVEN MITT D

Clip curves.

Clip curves and inward corner.

- 1. Baste BATTING to WRONG sides of each OVEN MITT (11) and two BAND (12) sections. Remaining bands will be used as facings.
- 2. Pin bands to oven mitts, RIGHT sides together, matching notches. Stitch. To reduce bulk, trim batting close to stitching. Optional: Pin rick rack to oven mitt, centering over seam. Stitch through center of rick rack. Baste ends.



- 3. Fold LOOP (13) in half lengthwise, WRONG sides together. Press. Open out long edges of loop and turn them to WRONG side so that they meet at the crease. Press. Fold loop in half lengthwise, bringing pressed edges together. Stitch close to both long edges.
 - 4. Fold loop in half having ends even. Baste. Pin loop to lower edge of band, next to small dot, as shown. Baste.

5. Pin oven mitts, RIGHT sides together, matching notches, band seams, and small dots. Stitch along seamline and stitching lines, leaving lower edge open. Trim batting close to stitching. Clip into inner corner at small dot, being careful not to clip into stitching.













- 8. Pin lining to oven mitt, RIGHT sides together, matching thumbs and seams, having lower edges even. Stitch lower edge.
