Suggested Fabrics: A,B,C,F and **Body and Hat D,E** in Cotton Types, Quilting Cottons. **Body and Hat E** also in Novelty Fleece, Velveteen. **Heads, Hands, Feet/Shoes D,E, Shorts and Hat Band D, Leaves F** in Felt. **Beard and Hair E:** Faux Fur. **Padding F:** Sew-in Fleece Interfacing.

Notions: **A:** 2" x 15.6" (5cm x 39cm) foam wreath form, roll of 5" (13cm) mesh ribbon, large ribbon bow, 7" (18cm) length of 3/8" (1cm) ribbon, assorted ornaments and sprigs, glue. **B:** One 9" (23cm) cone, one star pick, seventy two 1/4" (6mm) rhinestones, glue. **C:** One 5" (13cm) styrofoam ball, 10" (25cm) length of 1/4" (6mm) ribbon, large ribbon bow, assorted ornaments and sprigs, glue. **D:** Two 10mm beads, one 13mm pom-pom (for nose), five 1" (2.5cm) buttons, heavyweight thread, one pkg. of medium rick rack, two 3/8" (1cm) novelty buttons, cotton sport yarn, embroidery floss, three mini jingle bells, polyfiberfill, glue. **E:** Two 6mm beads, one 10mm (approx) bead (for nose), five 1" (2.5cm) buttons, small ribbon bow, bell charms, 2" x 2" (5cm x 5cm) remnant of glitter craft foam, polyfiberfill, glue. **F:** 10" (25cm) length of 3/8" (1cm) ribbon, one pkg. of metallic baby rick rack, four 1/4" - 3/8" (6mm - 10mm) rhinestones, glue.

Cutting Layouts



POSITION OF PATTERN PIECES MAY VARY SLIGHTLY ACCORDING TO YOUR PATTERN SIZE

General Directions For Cutting


- PRE-SHRINK** and iron all fabric.
- FOR DOUBLE THICKNESS** -Fold fabric with RIGHT sides together. Pin pattern to WRONG side of fabric.
- FOR SINGLE THICKNESS** -Pin pattern to RIGHT side of fabric.
- ★ If layout shows a piece extending past fold, cut out all pieces except piece that extends. Open out fabric to single thickness. Cut extending piece on RIGHT side of fabric in position shown.
- ✱ Mark small arrows along both selvages in dictating direction of nap or design. Fold fabric crosswise with RIGHT sides together, and cut along fold. Turn one fabric layer around so arrows on both layers go in the same direction. Place RIGHT sides together.

TIP: IF DESIRED, CUT MULTIPLE CIRCLES FROM CARDBOARD TEMPLATES MADE FROM PIECES 1, 2, AND 3.

Sewing Directions

FABRIC KEY



Read **General Directions** on page 1 before you begin.

Sewing methods in **BOLD TYPE** have Sewing Tutorial Video available. Scan **QR CODE** to watch videos:

SLIPSTITCH – see **Hand Stitching: “how to slip stitch”** video

TACK – see **Hand Stitches: “how to tack”** video

TRIM – see **Seams: “How to Sew: Trim, Clip, and Layer Seams”** video

Sewing procedures **BOLD/ITALICIZED** in Sewing Directions are defined below.

YO-YOS

TIP: When cutting out multiple circles for yo-yos, make a template by tracing shape onto cardboard. Cut the cardboard circle out and use to trace onto fabric.

Method 1: Thread a hand sewing needle with heavy thread. Double thread and knot the tail ends together. Hand gather outer edge of yo-yo 1/4”(6mm) from raw edge. With **RIGHT** side of fabric facing you and holding needle thread, pull the thread tightly to gather the circle, pulling until you have an almost closed circle. Knot thread ends securely. Apply to item as described in sewing instructions.

TIP: To prevent raw edges from fraying, apply Fray check™ or clear nail polish. Test on scrap fabric.

Method 2: Thread a hand sewing needle with heavy thread. Double thread and knot the tail ends together. Turning under raw edge of fabric 1/4”(6mm), hand gather outer edge of yo-yo close to fold. With **RIGHT** side of fabric facing you and holding needle thread, pull the thread tightly to gather the circle, pulling until you have an almost closed circle. Knot thread ends securely. Apply to item as described in sewing instructions.

TIP: When applying to item, use straight pins to hold position of yo-yos to test spacing. Remove pins and glue.

STUFF – Pull fiberfill apart and fluff it before you use it. Break apart the lumps and thick spots. This will help create a smoother looking project. Use small pieces and pack into place using the end of a long handled wooden spoon or chop-stick. Pack firmly in place each time stuffing is added. Use both hands to mold and shape, being careful not to over stuff or make lopsided.

OUTLINE STITCH – For outline stitching, work with as many threads as desired and use a large eyed needle. Bring thread to **RIGHT** side at A, down at B, up at C, etc. Always hold thread in the same position either all above or all below the needle for an even line.



WREATH A


1. Pin one end of ribbon to front of foam ring. Wrap ribbon around the ring and over the pinned end, but not covering the pin. Apply glue and let dry. Remove pin.

2. Continue wrapping the ribbon tightly around the ring, always slightly overlapping the ribbon of the previous turn and assuring the ribbon is tightly wound and secure before proceeding to the next wrap around. Once the ring is completely wrapped, glue the end of the ribbon to the front.







3. Make thirty-two **YO-YOS** using **LARGE YO YO** (1) and fourteen using **MEDIUM YO YO** (2). With gathered centers facing up, glue yo-yos onto the front and sides of wrapped ring, slightly overlapping one another.

4. To form loop for hanging, cut a length of 3/8”(1cm) wide ribbon 7”(18cm) long. Fold ribbon in half bringing ends together and glue to back of wreath at top.

Decorate wreath with purchased embellishments as desired or as shown on pattern envelope.

TREE B

1. Make eighteen **YO-YOS** from four different fabrics using **SMALL YO YO** (3), for a total of seventy two yo-yos. Glue a rhinestone to the center of each yo-yo.

2. With gathered sides facing up, glue a row of yo-yos to bottom of foam tree, overlapping the yo-yos and having the yo-yos extend slightly below the bottom of the tree. Randomly mix the different fabrics.


3. Glue the second row of yo-yos to the tree overlapping the first row, in the same manner. Continue gluing rows of overlapping yo-yos until the entire tree is covered. Insert star pick into top of tree.

TIP: For a stand, use an inverted plant saucer or candle holder.

KISSING BALL C

1. For hanging loop, Cut a length of 1/4”(6mm) wide ribbon, 10”(26cm) long. Fold ribbon in half, bringing ends together. Glue ends to foam ball. This will be the top.

2. Make twenty seven **YO-YOS** using **MEDIUM YO YO** (2). Glue two or three yo-yos to top of ball covering ends of hanging loop.




3. Continue gluing yo-yos to ball, overlapping as needed, until entire ball is covered.


Glue embellishments to top of ball as desired or as shown on pattern envelope.

ELF DOLL D


1. Cut out sections from HEAD, EARS AND HANDS (5). Set aside ears until a later step.



2. Embroider mouth along solid line on head using an **OUTLINE STITCH**.




3. Pin ears onto head front matching dots; baste. Pin head front to head back, **RIGHT** sides together. Stitch curved edge along stitching lines, leaving straight lower edge open. Clip curves. For each hand, pin two hand sections, **RIGHT** sides together, with raw edges even. Stitch along curved edge, leaving straight edge open. Clip curves and inward corner, being careful not to clip through stitching.




4. Cut out sections from SHORTS AND SHOES (6). Set aside shorts until a later step.


5. Pin two shoe sections, **RIGHT** sides together, with raw edges even. Stitch curved edges, leaving straight upper edge open. Clip curves. Trim corner




6. Turn head, hands, and shoes **RIGHT** side out. **STUFF** firmly. Turn in 1/4"(6mm) on opening edge. Hand gather around each opening close to fold. Pull gathers up tightly to close openings and knot securely.



7. For arms and legs, make eight **YO-YOS** out of seven different fabrics, using MEDIUM YO YO (2), for a total of fifty six yo-yos. Make four additional **YO-YOS** for a total of sixty. For body, make twelve **YO-YOS** using BODY (4).




8. To assemble leg, thread needle with a heavy weight thread about 36"(92cm) long and knot one end. Run thread through center of seventeen medium yo-yos of assorted fabrics, having the gathered side up. At the bottom of the yo-yo stack run thread in and out the center of the shoe and back up through the center of the yo-yos. At the top of the yo-yo stack run thread up through one hole of 1"(2.5cm) flat button and back down through opposite hole.



9. Run thread back down through center of yo-yos, through shoe, and back up yo-yos and through hole of button. Make a knot through thread at top of button. Do not cut thread. The thread ends will be used to attach legs to body. Make second leg in same manner.

10. Assemble each arm in same manner as legs using thirteen medium yo-yos and attaching hands at the bottom of the yo-yo stack. Do not cut thread ends.




11. To assemble body, thread needle with a long length of heavy weight thread and knot one end. Run thread through center of the twelve yo-yos for the body, having gathered side up. At the bottom, run the thread through one hole on remaining button and up through opposite hole on button. Run thread back up through the stack. Run thread through the stack again from top to bottom, through the button and back up to top. Knot. Do not cut thread. It will be used to attach body to head.




12. To attach legs to body, thread needle with thread at top of leg. Run thread through one hole on button at bottom of body, up through body and top yo-yo. Do not cut thread. Run thread on other leg through opposite hole on button in same manner. Knot thread ends together.

13. To attach arms, thread needle with thread at top of arm. Lift up top yo-yo on body and run thread down through body starting at the second yo-yo from the top. Go through button at bottom of stack and back up through body and out at top yo-yo. Knot end. Do not cut thread. Repeat for remaining arm.


14. To attach head to body, thread needle with one thread at top of body. Go in and out of head and down through body and knot thread at button on bottom of body. Repeat with remaining thread ends. Shape "neck" into a circle and pin to top yo-yo. With a separate thread, hand sew head in place going around twice to make secure. Knot ends and trim. Sew hands and shoes in same manner. Sew a bell to toe of shoes.


15. Glue beads to markings on head for eyes. Glue pom-pom to marking for nose. Glue strands of yarn to top of head for hair.




26. Pin rick rack along center of each strap. Stitch through center of rick rack.






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
1. Cut out sections from HEAD (12). Pin head front to head back, RIGHT sides together. Stitch curved edge along stitching lines, leaving straight lower edge open. Clip curves.





2. Turn RIGHT side out. **STUFF** firmly. Turn in 1/4"(6mm) on opening edge. Hand gather around opening close to fold. Pull gathers up tightly to close opening and knot securely.



3. Cut out sections from HANDS, FEET AND BELT (9). To make each hand and each foot, gather outer edge of each hand and foot section. Pull up gathers, leaving an opening for stuffing. **STUFF** firmly. Pull up gathers tightly to close opening and knot ends securely. Make **YO-YO** using belt section.




4. Cut out sections from BODY BAND, ARM BANDS, LEG BANDS AND HAT BAND (11). Set aside hat band. Make **YO-YOS** using body band, arm band, and leg band sections. For body, make eleven **YO-YOS** using LARGE YO YO (1). For arms and legs make forty-four **YO-YOS** using MEDIUM YO YO (2).




5. To assemble each leg, thread needle with a heavy weight thread about 36"(92cm) long and knot one end. Run thread through center of eleven yo-yos, having the gathered side up. At the bottom of leg band run thread in and out the center of the stuffed foot yo-yo and back up through the center of the yo-yos. At the top of the yo-yo stack run thread up through one hole of 1"(2.5cm) flat button and back down through opposite hole on button.

6. Run thread through foot, back up yo-yos and through hole of button again. Make a knot through thread at top of button. Do not cut thread. The thread ends will be used to attach legs to body. Make second leg in same manner. Assemble arms in same manner as legs, using the armband and hand at the bottom of the yo-yo stack.


7. To assemble body, thread needle with long length of heavy weight thread and knot one end. Run thread through center of six large yo-yos, having gathered side up. Add belt yo-yo and then five more large yo-yos, ending with the body band CONTRAST yo-yo. At the bottom, run the thread through one hole of remaining button and back up through opposite hole and up through the stack. Run thread through the stack again from top to bottom, through the button and back up to top. Knot. Do not cut thread. It will be used to attach body to head.



8. To attach legs to body, thread needle with thread at top of leg. Run thread through one hole on button on bottom of body, up through center of body to top yo-yo. Do not cut thread. Run thread on other leg through opposite hole on button, in same manner. Knot thread ends together.




9. To attach arms, thread needle with thread at top of arm. Lift up top yo-yo on body and run thread down through body starting at the second yo-yo from the top. Go through button, back up through body and out at top yo-yo. Knot end. Do not cut thread. Repeat for remaining arm.




10. To attach head to body, thread needle with one thread at top of body. Go in and out of head and down through body and knot thread at button on bottom of stack. Repeat for remaining thread ends. Shape "neck" into a circle and pin to top yo-yo. With a separate thread, hand sew head to top yo-yo, going around twice to make secure. Knot ends and trim.





11. Cut out sections from BEARD AND BACK HAIR (13). Glue beard to head front along placement line, matching center fronts. Sew beads to head front at markings for eyes and bead to head front at marking for nose. Glue back hair to head back along placement line, matching center backs.


12. Cut out BUCKLE APPLIQUE (10) from glitter craft foam and glue to front of belt yo-yo.






14. Stitch hat band sections RIGHT sides together at sides. Trim. With wrong sides together, fold band in half lengthwise.

15. Pin RIGHT side of hat band to WRONG side of hat at lower edge matching centers. Stitch.

16. Turn hat band to OUTSIDE. Press. Sew or glue pom-pom to tip of hat. Fold point of hat down and TACK to hat. Attach bell charms to bow and sew or glue bow to hat. Place hat on top of head. TACK or glue in place.




STOCKING F

1. Pin TOE (15) to STOCKING (14), RIGHT sides together, placing the 1/4"(6mm) seam allowance on toe below placement line on stocking. Stitch along 1/4"(6mm) seamline.

2. Turn toe over seam allowance, RIGHT side up, having raw edges even. Press. Baste raw edges together. Pin rick rack over seam. Stitch through center of rick rack.



3. Pin PADDING to WRONG side of stocking and two CUFF (16) sections, having edges even. Baste.






