**Suggested Fabrics:** Fleece, Minky Fleece. **A also in Shaggy Faux Fur.** **Appliqués C, D and Flowers C in Craft Felt.** **D Contrast 4 (Drape) in Tulle.** **Lining:** Interlock, Jersey Knit. **Interfacing:** Fusible Fleece.

**Notions:** **A, B, C, D:** ¼ yd. (0.8m) of 1" (2.5cm) elastic, 4" (10cm) length of ¾" (2cm) hook and loop tape. **Also for A, B:** Four 1" (2.5cm) sew-in snaps, ¾ yd. (0.8m) of ½" (1.3cm) elastic (for wings), ½ yd. (0.5m) of ¼" (6mm) elastic (for hat), one small snap (for hat). **D:** Polyfiller, one 6" (15cm) chenille stem.

## Cutting Layouts



POSITION OF PATTERN PIECES MAY VARY  
SLIGHTLY ACCORDING TO YOUR PATTERN SIZE

### General Directions For Cutting

**PRE-SHRINK** and iron all fabric.

**FOR DOUBLE THICKNESS** -Fold fabric with RIGHT sides together. Pin pattern to WRONG side of fabric.

**FOR SINGLE THICKNESS** -Pin pattern to RIGHT side of fabric.


★ If layout shows a piece extending past fold, cut out all pieces except piece that extends. Open out fabric to single thickness. Cut extending piece on RIGHT side of fabric in position shown.

✱ Mark small arrows along both selvages in dicating direction of nap or design. Fold fabric crosswise with RIGHT sides together, and cut along fold. Turn one fabric layer around so arrows on both layers go in the same direction. Place RIGHT sides together.

## Sewing Directions

FABRIC KEY RIGHT SIDE WRONG SIDE INTERFACING LINING LINING

Read **General Directions** on page 1 before you begin.

Sewing methods in **BOLD TYPE** have Sewing Tutorial Video available. Scan QR CODE to watch videos:

**EASE/GATHER** - Stitch along seamline and again 1/4" (6mm) away in seam allowance, using long machine stitches. Pull thread ends when adjusting to fit.

**TOPSTITCH** - On outside, stitch 1/4" (6mm) from edge, seam or previous stitching, using presser foot as guide, or stitch where indicated in instructions.

**FINISH** - Stitch 1/4" (6mm) from raw edge and finish with one of the following: (1) Pink OR (2) Overcast OR (3) Turn in along stitching and stitch close to fold OR (4) Overlock.

OPTIONAL FOR HEMS: Apply Seam Binding.

**SLIPSTITCH** - Slide needle through a folded edge, then pick up a thread of underneath fabric.

## SIMPLY THE BEST TECHNIQUES FOR SEWING FLEECE

- Fleece fabric is strong, hard to puncture or tear and doesn't ravel or get pilly.
- Since cut edges of fleece fabrics do not ravel, inner edges of seams and hems can be left raw.
- When pinning pieces together, use long pins...the kind with bead heads are best because short pins tend to get lost in the fleece.
- When stitching, try using a narrow zig-zag stitch, adjusting the width and length for the type of fleece you are using. Always test first on some scraps and keep for reference.
- Sew slowly and carefully the first time you stitch a seam as stitches are hard to remove.
- To prevent shoulder seams from stretching, pin center of hem tape or twill tape along seam line on front shoulder edges, then stitch the shoulder seams.
- When sewing around shaped areas sew slowly being careful not to stretch the fleece as you feed fabric through your machine.
- Finger press or steam press on a low temperature setting using a press cloth.
- Raw edges can also be cut with pinking shears.







## GENERAL DIRECTIONS FOR APPLIQUES

## PREPARING APPLIQUES

- A.** Apply paper backed fusible web to **WRONG** side of applique fabric, following manufacturer's directions. Cut applique tissue block along outer solid line. Pin pattern to **RIGHT** side of prepared fabric. Cut out each applique. Transfer markings to **RIGHT** side of applique using a washable fabric marking pen or pencil.

## APPLYING APPLIQUES

- B.** Pin applique(s) to garment as instructed in Sewing Directions. Be sure to clear all seam allowances, when necessary. A glue stick can be used to temporarily hold the applique(s) in place before stitching. Fuse appliques in place, following manufacturer's directions. Straight OR Zig-zag (satin) stitch along raw edges and/or broken lines or use fabric paint to seal the edges. Allow paint to dry before you continue.  
**NOTE:** Applique stitching will not be shown in future illustrations.



PATTERN PIECES WILL BE IDENTIFIED BY NUMBERS THE FIRST TIME THEY ARE USED.

STITCH SEAMS WITH RIGHT SIDES TOGETHER UNLESS OTHERWISE STATED.

**NOTE:** View A will be shown unless otherwise indicated. Front and Back Facing for View A only is cut from lining and interfaced.

## INTERFACING

- 1.** Pin INTERFACING to wrong side of each matching FABRIC section. Fuse, following manufacturer's instructions.

## FRONT AND BACK

- 2.** With **RIGHT** sides together, pin **SIDE FRONT AND BACK** (2) to each side of **FRONT AND BACK** (1) section (use contrast front section for **View B**). Stitch. Press seams open. Construct back in same manner as for front.












- 3. VIEW C- PREPARE SEEDS APPLIQUE** (15). **APPLY** appliques to front, as shown on front of envelope OR as desired.

- 4. VIEW A, B, C- FINISH** lower edge of **FRONT AND BACK FACING** (3) sections.

- 5.** With **RIGHT** sides together, pin one front and back facing to upper edge of each front and back section, having raw edges even. Stitch neck, armhole, and shoulder edges, leaving side seams free. Trim seam, clip curves.

- 6.** Turn facing to **INSIDE**. Press.

- 7.** Open out facings at side edges. With **RIGHT** sides together, stitch front to back at side seams from lower edge to edge of facing, matching armhole seams and notches.



- 8.** Turn facing back in place. **TOPSTITCH** neck and armhole edges as shown.  
Hand-tack facing at side seams.

### FINISHING

- 9.** Cut two pieces of hook and loop tape each measuring 1-3/4" (4.5cm) long. Separate tape.  
On **OUTSIDE**, pin loop (soft) half of tape to back shoulder edges, as shown. On **INSIDE** pin remaining hook (rough) half of tape to shoulder edges of front, as shown.  
Stitch along outer edges of tape.
- 10.** Press 1-1/2" (3.8cm) on lower edge of garment to **INSIDE**, forming casing.  
Press under 1/4" (6mm) on raw edge.  
Stitch close to pressed edge of casing, leaving an opening to insert elastic.
- 11.** Cut a piece of elastic to the length of **GUIDE FOR ELASTIC (4)**. Insert elastic through casing.  
Overlap ends and hold with a safety pin.  
Try on garment and adjust to fit, if necessary.
- 12.** Stitch ends of elastic together securely. Stitch opening closed. Distribute fullness evenly.  
**TIP-** To secure elastic so it won't twist in wearing, stitch through all thicknesses of casing in the groove of each seam.
- 13.** **VIEW A, B-** Separate heavy-duty snaps on **OUTSIDE**, hand-sew socket half snaps to front and back armhole edges at markings.  
**NOTE:** Remaining half of snaps will be used in a later step.

- 14.** **VIEW C- GATHER** upper edge of **COLLAR FRONT (9)** along gathering line, between small dots.

- 15.** On **OUTSIDE**, pin **WRONG** side of collar to **RIGHT** side of front matching small dots. Adjust gathers to fit. Baste. Stitch.

- 16.** **GATHER** upper edge of **COLLAR BACK (10)** along gathering line, between large dots.









- 17.** On **OUTSIDE**, pin **WRONG** side of collar to **RIGHT** side of back matching large dots. Adjust gathers to fit. Baste. Stitch.

- 18.** **PREPARE** one **FLOWER APPLIQUE (13)** block and **FLOWER CIRCLE APPLIQUE (14)**. Fuse flower center to each flower on prepared block, centering edges along placement lines. Fuse prepared applique to remaining applique block (13). Cut out each applique along solid lines.  
Hand-sew **OR** glue flower applique to **LEFT** side of front, as shown on front of envelope **OR** as desired.  
**NOTE:** Remaining flower applique will be used for the hat in a later step.

### WINGS

- 19.** Cut two pieces of elastic each the length of lower edge of **WING (5)** between large dots, plus seam allowances.  
On **OUTSIDE**, pin elastic to lower edge of two wing sections, centering ends over large dots, as shown. Baste.  
**NOTE:** The side with the elastic will be the **UNDERSIDE** of the wing, facing the body.

- 20.** With **RIGHT** sides together, pin wing sections together, having raw edges even. Stitch along outer edge, leaving an opening large enough for turning at side. Trim seam, clip curves.



- 21.** Turn wing **RIGHT** side out, press. **SLIPSTITCH** opening closed.  
On **UNDERSIDE**, pin remaining socket half of snap to upper edge of each wing at small dots. Fasten wing to shoulder seams while wearing.



#### INTERFACING


- 1.** Pin **INTERFACING** to wrong side of each matching **FABRIC** section. Fuse, following manufacturer's instructions.

#### FRONT AND BACK


- 2.** Construct two front and back sections as follows:  
With **RIGHT** sides together, stitch **UPPER SIDE FRONT AND SIDE BACK (17)** sections to each side of **UPPER FRONT AND BACK (16)**, matching notches.
- 3.** With **RIGHT** sides together, stitch **LOWER SIDE FRONT AND SIDE BACK (19)** sections to each side of **LOWER FRONT AND BACK (18)**, matching notches.
- 4.** With **RIGHT** sides together, pin upper and lower front and back sections together at middle, matching notches. Stitch. Press seam open.
- 5.** Apply paper backed fusible web to **WRONG** side of **BAND APPLIQUE (21)**.  
On **OUTSIDE**, pin band to each front and back section, placing one long edge along placement line, with lower edge of band covering seam, as shown.  
Fuse band in place, following manufacturer's directions. Stitch close to raw edges of band.
- 6.** **PREPARE** **SPRINKLES APPLIQUE (20)**. **APPLY** appliques evenly, to each front and back section, as shown on front of envelope **OR** as desired.
- 7.** **FINISH** lower edge of **FRONT AND BACK FACING (3)** sections.




- 8.** With RIGHT sides together, pin one front and back facing to upper edge of each front and back section, having raw edges even. Stitch neck, armhole, and shoulder edges, leaving side seams free. Trim seam, clip curves.




- 9.** Turn facing to INSIDE. Press.




- 10.** Open out facings at side edges. With RIGHT sides together, stitch front to back at side seams from lower edge to edge of facing, matching armhole seams and notches.




- 11.** Turn facing back in place. **TOPSTITCH** neck and armhole edges as shown. Tack facing to seams.




- 12.** Layer four layers of **DRAPE** (22) sections together, having raw edges even. Hand-baste raw edges together.




- 13.** With RIGHT sides together, stitch center back seam of drape.



- 14.** Fold long edges of drape sections to INSIDE, having raw edges meet at center. Press.



- 15.** Fold drape along center fold line, bringing pressed edges together.  
Sew a line of one row **GATHERS** along gathering lines and along center back seam.



- 16.** On OUTSIDE, pin drape to center of body, having lower edge just covering upper edge of trim, and matching gathering lines to small dots, and center back. Adjust gathers to fit between small dots. Baste. Stitch through all thickness to secure.

#### FINISHING

To attach hook and loop tape at shoulders and construct lower casing, see View A, B, C- steps 9 through 12.

**NOTE:** View A will be shown unless otherwise indicated.


#### INTERFACING

- 1.** Pin INTERFACING to wrong side of each matching FABRIC section. Fuse, following manufacturer's instructions.

#### FRONT AND BACK

- 2. VIEW A-** With RIGHT sides together, stitch outer edges of **COMB** (8) sections together, having raw edges even, leaving lower edge free. Trim seam. Clip curves and to inner corners at small dots.

- 3.** Turn comb RIGHT side out. Press. **GATHER** lower edge.




4. On OUTSIDE, pin comb to upper edge of HAT FRONT (6), matching small dots. Adjust gathers. Baste.



5. **VIEW A, B-** Machine-stitch 1/2"(1.3cm) away from outer edge of HAT FRONT (6) section.




6. With RIGHT sides together, stitch center back seam of HAT BACK AND SIDE (7) sections, matching notches. Trim seam. Clip curves. Press seam open.




7. With RIGHT sides together, pin hat back to front at sides, matching notches, clipping to stitching, as necessary. Baste. Stitch. Trim seam. Clip curves.




8. Cut a piece of elastic to fit comfortably under the neck, plus seam allowances. Turn under 1/4"(6mm) on one end of elastic. Hand-sew socket half of snap to pressed edge of elastic, as shown.




9. With snap facing up, pin elastic to lower edge of hat, centering end at small dot. Baste. **TIP:** Pin free end of tie out of the way, when stitching remaining seams.




10. Machine-stitch 1/2"(1.3cm) away from outer edge of hat front lining section.



11. With RIGHT sides together, stitch center back seam of hat back and side lining sections, matching notches. Trim seam.



12. With RIGHT sides together, pin hat back to front lining at sides, matching notches, clipping to stitching, as necessary. Baste. Stitch, leaving an opening large enough for turning. Trim seam. Clip curves.



13. With RIGHT sides together, pin lining to hat matching centers and seams. Stitch lower edge of hat. Trim seam. Clip curves.




14. Turn hat RIGHT side out, through opening. Press. **SLIPSTITCH** opening closed. On INSIDE, sew remaining half of snap to hat just above small dot, as shown. **Fasten elastic using snaps, while wearing.**


2. With RIGHT sides together, stitch center back seam of HAT BAND (12).




3. Fold band in half lengthwise, with WRONG sides together. Pin.



4. With WRONG sides together, pin HAT TOP (11) fabric and lining sections together, having raw edges even. **GATHER** outer edge of hat top, breaking stitching at notches.




5. With RIGHT sides together, pin hat top to band matching centers and notches, adjusting gathers to fit. Baste. Stitch. Stitch again 1/4"(6mm) away within seam allowance. Trim close to second stitching. Press seam toward top, pressing band out.




6. **VIEW D- GATHER** outer edge of CHERRY (23) along gathering line.




7. Pull up gathering stitches forming a ball. Lightly stuff cherry to desired thickness, tightening gathering stitching at UNDERSIDE. Secure thread ends.



8. Cut a piece of pipe cleaner approximately 5"(13cm) long. Cut a small opening at top of cherry at small dot, smaller than width of pipe cleaner. Insert pipe cleaner into cherry as far as desired. **TIP:** Make small stitches OR use fabric paint/glue to secure pipe cleaner at opening.



9. On OUTSIDE, hand-sew cherry to top of hat, as shown on front of envelope or desired.



10. **VIEW C-** Hand-sew or glue remaining flower applique to front of hat, as shown on front of envelope OR as desired.
