GENERAL DIRECTIONS FOR APPLIQUES PREPARING APPLIQUES

A. Apply paper backed fusible web to WRONG side of applique fabric, following manufacturer's directions.

Pin pattern to RIGHT side of prepared fabric. Cut out each applique. Transfer markings to RIGHT side of applique using a washable fabric marking pen or pencil.

APPLYING APPLIQUES

B. Pin applique(s) to project as instructed in Sewing Directions. Be sure to clear all seam allowances, where necessary. A glue stick can be used to temporarily hold the applique(s) in place before stitching. Fuse appliques in place, following manufacturer's directions. Then, stitch fused applique over outer raw edges, using a narrow satin

NOTE: Applique stitching will not be shown in further illustrations.

GENERAL DIRECTIONS FOR APPLYING DOUBLE FOLD **BIAS TAPE**

Double fold bias tape comes with one side slightly wider than the other. The wider side is used on the INSIDE so that when the tape is stitched in place from the OUTSIDE, both edges are caught in the

If tape is applied to a curved surface, first, pre-shape it with a steam iron. For an inward curve, stretch the double edges and press; for an

TIP FOR SHAPING TRIM- Place trim along the pattern tissue and then follow instructions above.

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EDGESTITCH - On OUTSIDE, stitch close to finished edge or

GATHER - Loosen needle tension slightly. With RIGHT side up, stitch along

seam line using a long machine stitch, leaving long thread ends. Stitch again 1/4" (6mm) inside the seam line.

NARROW HEM - Press under hem allowance as indicated on tissue pattern. To form narrow hem, tuck under raw edge to meet crease.

Press, Stitch hem in place

SLIPSTITCH - Slide needle through a folded edge, then pick up a thread of underneath fabric.

STAY-STITCH - Stitch 1/2" (1.3cm) from cut edge in direction of arrows. This stitching stays in permanently to prevent stretching on curved edges. (Shown only in the first illustration).

PATTERN PIECES WILL BE IDENTIFIED BY NUMBERS THE FIRST TIME THEY ARE USED.

STITCH 5/8" (1.5CM) SEAMS WITH RIGHT SIDES TOGETHER UNLESS OTHERWISE STATED.

APRON A


NOTE: You have cut out four front and back sections. You will use one section for the front of the apron and one for the back. When completed, these will be on the outside of the apron. The remaining sections will be used as facings and when completed, will be on the inside, facing your body.

1. STAY-STITCH armhole edges of each FRONT AND BACK (1) section in direction of arrows.

Stay-stitching won't be shown in the following illustrations.

2. Stitch two POCKET (6) sections together along side and lower edges, leaving straight edge open. Trim seam; clip curves. Turn pocket; press.







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- 3. Apply bias tape to raw edge of pocket, turning in ends. See GENERAL DIRECTIONS FOR DOUBLE FOLD BIAS TAPE. Invisibly SLIPSTITCH ends of tape together.
- 4. On outside, pin pocket to apron front along pocket line. EDGESTITCH side and lower edges.



APPLY two sunflowers matching large dots, forming bottom laver of petals.

APPLY remaining sunflowers over previous sunflowers, matching large dots and rotating flower so that you can see bottom petals, as shown.

APPLY sunflower centers over sunflowers within solid lines, matching large dots.

- 6. NOTE: You have cut out eight strap sections. Four will be used for the straps and four for the strap facings. For each strap, stitch two SHOULDER STRAP (2) sections together at shoulders, matching notches.
- 7. Stitch shoulder seams of strap facing sections same as for strap


Pin facing to strap, matching seams and having raw edge even.

Stitch in a 1/4" (6mm) seam, leaving ends open. Turn strap; press. Baste raw edges together.



Stitch in a 1/4" (6mm) seam, leaving ends with small and large dots open.


Turn tie; press. Baste raw edges together.



 With RIGHT sides together, baste straps to upper edge of apron front, matching small and large dots.
 Baste one tie to each side edge, matching small and large dots.

TIP- Pin free ends of straps and ties to front with safety pins to prevent them from getting caught in the seam later.






10. Stitch two RUFFLE SIDE (5) sections to ends of RUFFLE CENTER (4), matching notches and forming one long ruffle.

GATHER straight edge of ruffle.

Turn up 1/2" (1.3cm) hem on raw edge; finish with a **NARROW HEM.**


TIP- To hem curved areas, stitch a scant 1/4" (10mm) from raw edge. Hem as above, pulling in thread to ease in fullness. Stitch remaining ruffle sections in same manner and set aside for apron back.

11. With RIGHT sides together, pin ruffle to apron front, having seams at lower small dots, matching centers, and remaining small dots. Pull up gathering stitches on wrong side to fit, distributing fullness evenly. Raste.




12. Pin front facing to apron front matching centers, small, and large dots.

Stitch, leaving an opening on armhole edge for turning, being careful not to catch in free edges of straps, ties, and ruffle. Trim seam and corners; clip curves where necessary.




13. Turn apron through opening in armhole, turning out straps, ties, and ruffle. Press.

Invisibly SLIPSTITCH opening closed.



14. Baste remaining ruffle and tie ends to back in same manner as for front

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


15. Baste raw edges of straps to upper edge of back, matching small and large dots.

16. With RIGHT sides together, pin back facing to back (sandwiching front apron), matching centers, small, and large dots.

Stitch, leaving an opening on armhole edge for turning, being careful not to catch in free edges of straps, ties, and ruffle.

Trim seam and corner: clip curves where necessary.




17. Turn back RIGHT side out. Press. SLIPSTITCH opening closed.

3. Stitch two POCKET (14) sections together along side and lower edges, leaving straight edge open. Trim seam; clip curves. Turn pocket; press. Baste raw edges together.

4. To make pleat in pocket, on OUTSIDE, fold along solid lines to small dots, bringing folds to center; pin.

Baste across raw edge. Press.

TIP- Hand baste along solid lines to small dots through both thicknesses of pockets. Fold along bastings to make

5. FOR MISSES:

For each pocket, cut a piece of 1" (2.5cm) single fold bias tape about 1" (2.5cm) longer than upper edge of the pocket.

Fold tape along length so that you have one side a slightly less wide than the other, as shown. Press. Apply to raw edge of pocket in same manner as for double fold bias tape, turning in ends. See GENERAL DIRECTIONS FOR DOUBLE FOLD BIAS TAPE. Invisibly SLIPSTITCH ends of tape together. FOR CHILD:

For each pocket, cut a piece of 1/2" (1.3cm) double fold bias tape to raw edge of pocket, turning in ends. See GENERAL DIRECTIONS FOR DOUBLE FOLD BIAS TAPE. Invisibly SLIPSTITCH ends of tape together.

6. On outside, pin pocket to apron front along pocket line. EDGESTITCH side and lower edges.

NOTE: You have cut out eight strap sections. Four will be used for the straps and will be trimmed with bias tape. The remaining sections will be used as strap facings.

 For each strap, cut two pieces of bias tape a bit longer than length of SHOULDER STRAP (12). Center and pin tape over solid line on front and back strap sections.
 EDGESTITCH outer edges of tape.
 Baste across ends.

8. Stitch front and back strap together at shoulders, matching notches

9. Stitch shoulder seams of strap facing sections same as for strap.

 Pin facing to strap, matching seams and having raw edge even.


Stitch in a 1/4" (6mm) seam, leaving ends open. Turn strap; press.

Baste across raw edges.

10. Apply interfacing to WRONG side of two TAB (13) sections. The remaining sections will be used as tab facings.

11. With RIGHT side together, stitch facing to tab in a 1/4" (6mm) seam, leaving end with large dots open. Trim corners.

Turn tab; press. Baste raw edges together. Make buttonhole at marking.



17. Turn back RIGHT side out. Press. SLIPSTITCH opening closed.

18. On OUTSIDE, sew buttons to back of apron at small dots.

TOWEL C AND D

NOTE: You will be making your own pattern for the band trim. The finished width of the band will be 4" (10cm), as shown on envelope (if desired, you can make your band as wide as 6" (15cm).

- 1. Measure the short edge of your purchased towel. On a piece of paper, draw an 8-1/4" (21cm) wide rectangle the length of your measurement plus 1/8" (6mm) for sewing ease. Add 1/2" (1.3cm) seam allowance to each edge. Cut out band.
- 2. Using a water-soluble marking pen or pencil, mark a straight line on towel 4" (110cm) in from one short edge. With RIGHT sides together, pin band to one short edge of towel, having seam line along marked line and ends evenly extended. Stitch along seam line.
- **3.** Press band out. Press under 1/2" (1.3cm) on remaining long edge of band.

With RIGHT sides together and raw edges even, fold band in half, placing pressed edge along seam.

Stitch ends in 1/2" (1.3cm) seams. Trim corners.

 Turn band RIGHT side out. Pin free edge along seam line, placing pins on TOPSIDE. EDGESTITCH band on TOPSIDE, catching in pressed edge on UNDERSIDE.

NOTE: Before applying appliques, arrange appliques on towel as shown in Sewing Instructions or as desired. Mark towel for placement of each applique using a washable fabric marking pen or pencil.

5. FOR TOWEL C

Prepare SUNFLOWER APPLIQUE (19), SUNFLOWER CENTER APPLIQUE (20), SMALL FLOWER APPLIQUE (21), and SMALL FLOWER CENTER APPLIQUE (22). Apply appliques to one side of towel in the following order,

APPLY small flowers as shown or as desired.

APPLY small flower centers over small flowers within broken

lines, matching small dots.

APPLY one sunflower as desired, forming bottom layer of petals.

APPLY remaining sunflower over previous sunflower, matching large dots and rotating flower so that you can see bottom petals, as shown.

APPLY sunflower center over sunflower within broken lines, matching large dots.

6. TOWEL D:

Prepare HEART APPLIQUE (23), PETAL CENTER APPLIQUE (24), PETAL SIDE APPLIQUE (25), and DOT APPLIQUE (26).

APPLY appliques to one side of towel in the following order:

APPLY heart applique as shown or as desired.

APPLY petal centers as desired.

APPLY side petals, matching small dots and having inner edges along broken lines.

APPLY dots at small dots on petals.
