**SEASONAL WREATHS**

**Suggested Fabrics:** Cotton Types, Quilting Cotton. **Interfacing:** Fusible Foam Stabilizer. **E.F.:** Paper-backed fusible web.

**Notions:** **A,B:** 12" (30cm) wire wreath form, polyfiberfill. **Also for A:** 8 yds. (7.3m) of ¼" (6mm) ribbon, one spider web charm, ½ yd. (0.4m) of ¼" (3mm) ribbon (for charm). **Also for B:** 8 yds. (7.3m) of ¾" (1cm) ribbon, three large jingle bells, 1½ yds. (1.4m) of ¼" (6mm) ribbon (for bells). **C,D:** 12" (30cm) styrofoam ring, 9 yds. (8.4m) of 1" (2.5cm) grosgrain ribbon (to wrap around ring), fabric glue or small straight pins. **Also for C,D,E,F:** ¼ yd. (0.2m) of ¼" (6mm) ribbon, 1" (2.5cm) star appliques, buttons, charms, gem glue.

**Wreath A**

One 14" x 18" (36cm x 46cm) remnant in each of seven different fabrics

**Wreath B**

One 14" x 18" (36cm x 46cm) remnant in each of seven different fabrics

**Wreath C**

One 22" x 18" (56cm x 46cm) remnants in each of seven different fabrics

**Interfacing:** 60" - ¾ yd. (150cm - 0.6m)

**Paper-Backed Fusible Web:** 17" - 1½ yds. (43cm - 1.0m)

**Contrast 2 (Honeycomb Print Outer Petal Backings):** 45\*\* - ¾ yd. (115cm\* - 0.7m)

**Interfacing:** 60" - ¾ yd. (150cm - 0.7m)

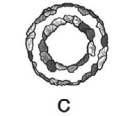

## Cutting Layouts



POSITION OF PATTERN PIECES MAY VARY SLIGHTLY ACCORDING TO YOUR PATTERN SIZE

### General Directions For Cutting

**PRE-SHRINK** and iron all fabric.

**FOR DOUBLE THICKNESS** -Fold fabric with **RIGHT** sides together. Pin pattern to **WRONG** side of fabric.

**FOR SINGLE THICKNESS** -Pin pattern to **RIGHT** side of fabric.

★ If layout shows a piece extending past fold, cut out all pieces except piece that extends. Open out fabric to single thickness. Cut extending piece on **RIGHT** side of fabric in position shown.

✱ Mark small arrows along both selvages indicating direction of nap or design. Fold fabric crosswise with **RIGHT** sides together, and cut along fold. Turn one fabric layer around so arrows on both layers go in the same direction. Place **RIGHT** sides together.

### WREATH A,B

CUT FIVE OF PIECE 1 IN EACH OF SEVEN DIFFERENT 18" X 14" (46CM X 36CM) FABRICS.

### WREATH C

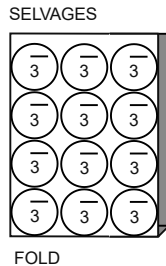
CUT FOUR OF PIECE 2, AND SEVEN OF PIECE 3, IN EACH OF SEVEN DIFFERENT 22" X 18" (56CM X 46CM) FABRICS.

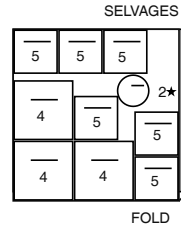

## Sewing Directions

FABRIC KEY RIGHTSIDE WRONGSIDE INTERFACING LINING LINING

Read **General Directions** on page 1 before you begin.

Sewing terms appearing in **BOLD TYPE** in Sewing Instructions are explained below.

**MAKE YO-YOS** - Thread a hand-sewing needle. Knot the tail end. Hand-gather raw edges of yo-yo circle along gathering line. With right side of fabric facing you, and holding the needle thread, pull the thread to gather the circle, carefully tucking the raw edge into the center for a clean finish. Gather until you have an almost-closed circle.

Knot thread ends securely. Press yo-yo flat, centering the gathered hole. Apply to wreath as instructed in sewing directions.

**PATTERN PIECES WILL BE IDENTIFIED BY NUMBERS THE FIRST TIME THEY ARE USED.**

STITCH SEAMS WITH RIGHT SIDES TOGETHER UNLESS OTHERWISE STATED.

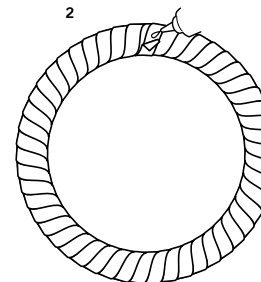
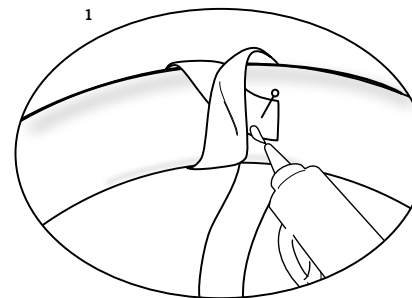
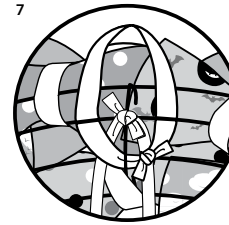
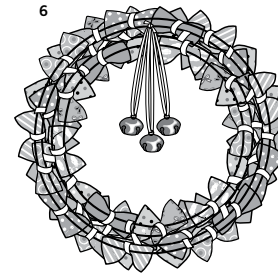
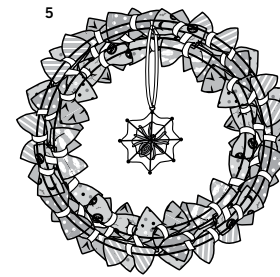
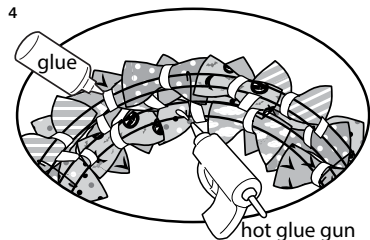
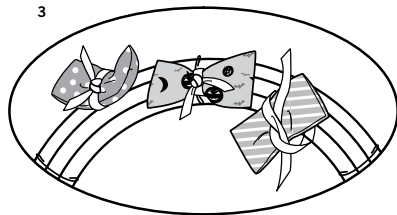
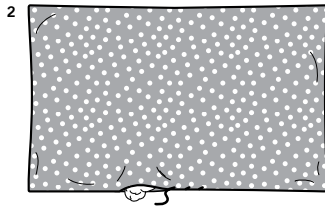
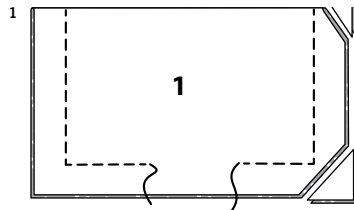
1. Fold each mini pillow (1) in half along foldline with wrong sides together. Stitch, leaving an opening for turning. Trim corners

2. Turn pillow right side out. Stuff each pillow with a handful of fiberfill. SLIPSTITCH opening edges together.

3. **FOR VIEW A** - Cut 35 pieces of 1/4" (6mm) wide ribbon, each 8" (20.5cm) in length. Trim ends diagonally.

**FOR VIEW B** - Cut 35 pieces of 3/8" (1cm) wide ribbon, each 8" (20.5cm) in length. Trim ends diagonally. Tie pillows to front of wire wreath frame one at a time, looping ribbon around two rings at a time; knotting the ends to temporarily secure the pillows in place. Tie first pillows to first and second outermost rings. Tie the second to the second and third rings, the next pillow to the third and fourth rings as shown, alternating fabric prints as desired. Continue tying order until all pillows are attached to the wire wreath.

4. On the back side of the frame, secure pillows to frame and one another using fabric glue or a medium hot glue gun.



5. **VIEW A** - Cut a piece of 1/8" (3mm) wide ribbon, 10" - 12" (25.5cm - 30.5cm) in length. Attach spider charm to the center of ribbon. Secure ends of the ribbon to the back of the frame so that the spider charm hangs in center opening as shown.

6. **VIEW B** - Cut two pieces of 1/4" (6mm) wide ribbon, each 10" (25.5cm) in length. Cut another piece of ribbon 14" (35.5cm) in length. Insert ribbons through shank on each bell. Arrange the bells at different lengths and knot ribbon ends together. Tie ends to back of frame so bells hang in the center opening.

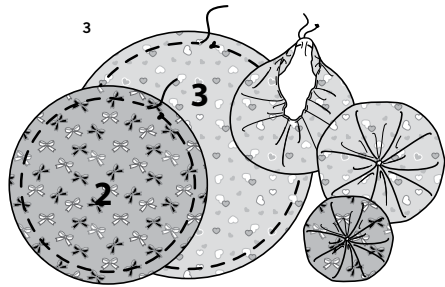
7. To form the hanging loop, cut another piece of ribbon 8" (20.5cm) in length and secure to back of the wire frame as shown.

### WREATH C OR D

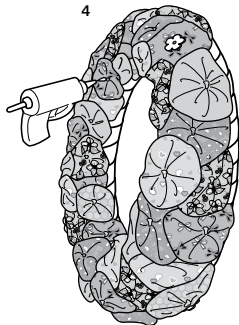
**NOTE:** To cover Styrofoam ring, and work more efficiently, we recommend using a hot glue gun. Use straight pins to securely hold grosgrain ribbon in place until glued. Avoid using excessive amounts of glue, dabbing glue only along the front of the wreath. Remove pins once ribbon is securely in place.

1. Pin one end of ribbon to foam front. Wrap ribbon around the ring, and over the pinned end, but not covering the pin. Apply glue and remove pin.

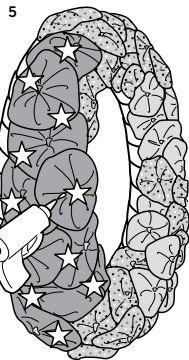
2. Continue wrapping the ribbon tightly around the ring, always slightly overlapping the ribbon of the previous turn, and assuring the ribbon is tightly wound and secure before proceeding to the next wrap around. Once the ring is completely wrapped, glue the end of ribbon to the front.



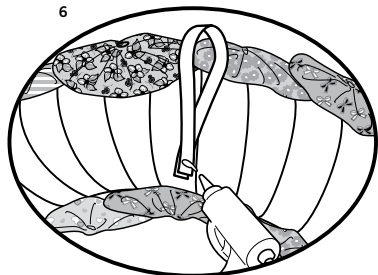
- 3.** Make yo-yos from small yo-yo (2) and large yo-yo (3) pattern pieces.



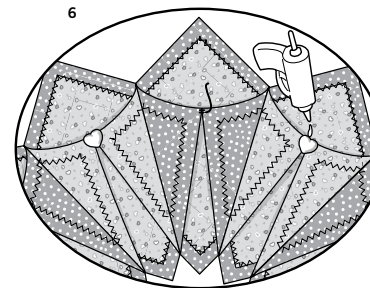
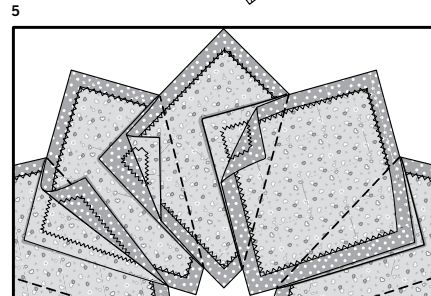
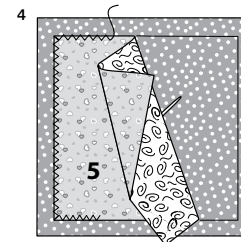
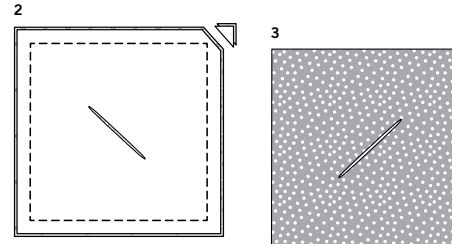
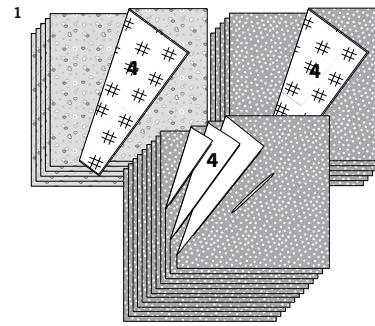
- 4. VIEW C** - With gathered centers facing up, glue yo-yos onto the front and sides of the covered ring. Arrange as desired, slightly overlapping one another and alternating fabric colors. Glue gemstone buttons to center of random yo-yos, distributing them evenly throughout the wreath.



- 5. VIEW D** - Separate one of the contrast color yo-yos into two equal groups. Separate the second set of contrast color yo-yos into three equal groups. With gathered centers facing up, arrange and pin the contrast groups onto the front and sides of the covered ring slightly overlapping on another as shown on envelope, or in a circular manner to your liking. Pin main fabric yo-yos in place last. Once satisfied with the arrangement, glue the yo-yos in place, removing all pins. Glue stars onto the final group of yo-yos.



- 6. VIEW C OR D** - To form the hanging loop, cut a piece of 1/4" (6mm) wide ribbon 4" (10cm) in length and glue to back of the wreath.



## WREATH E OR F

*NOTE: Transfer marking to RIGHT side of fabric using a washable fabric marker or pencil.*

### VIEW E

- 1.** Apply (Fusible Foam) interfacing to WRONG side of the six fabric sections, and six of the eighteen contrast color petal (4) sections, following manufacturer's instructions. Cut a diagonal slit approximately 2" (5cm) in length in the center of remaining petal sections.

- 2.** With RIGHT sides together, pin sections with slits to interfaced petals. Stitch all sides in a 1/2" (1.3cm) seam. Trim corners.

- 3.** Turn petals RIGHT side out through slit openings, pushing out corners. Press.

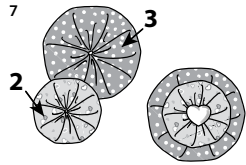
- 4.** Apply paper back fusible web to WRONG side of each applique (5) following manufacturer's instructions. Pin appliques to front of each petal, over the slit having raw edges along placement lines. Press. Stitch along raw edges of applique through all thicknesses, using a wide zig-zag stitch.

- 5.** With front of petals facing upward, pin side edges together, matching stitching lines, alternating back fabric prints and having finished edges even as shown. Stitch on stitching line through all thicknesses, completing a full circle of twelve petals.

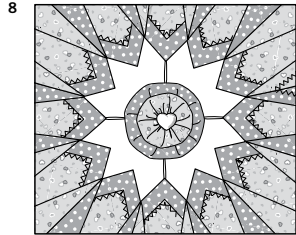
- 6.** On the front, bring side points of each petal together, forming cone-like shapes. Tack points together. Glue novelty buttons to wreath as shown on envelope.

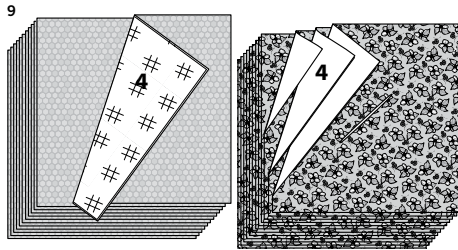
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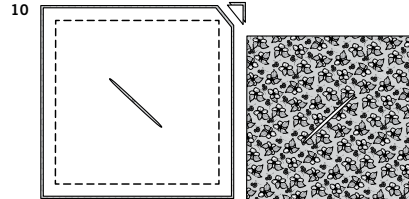
7. Make yo-yos from small yo-yo (2) and large yo-yo (3) pattern pieces. Center and glue small yo-yo over large yo-yo as shown. Glue button to center of small yo-yo.



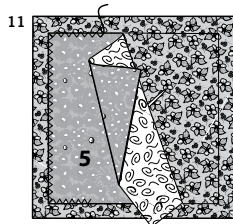
8. Attach yo-yos to center of wreath using fishing line as shown.

**VIEW F**

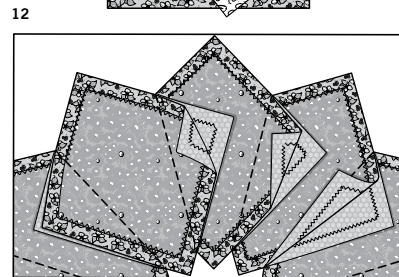
9. Apply (Fusible Foam) interfacing to WRONG side of all outer petal (4) sections, cut of contrast 2, following manufacturer's instructions. Cut a diagonal slit approximately 2" (5cm) in length in the center of all outer petals cut of contrast 1.



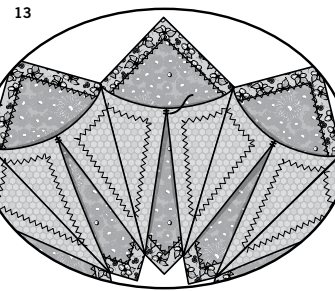
10. With RIGHT sides together, pin a contrast 1 outer petal to a contrast 2 outer petal. Stitch all sides in a 1/2" (1.3cm) seam. Trim corners. Turn petals right side out through slit openings, pushing out corners. Press.



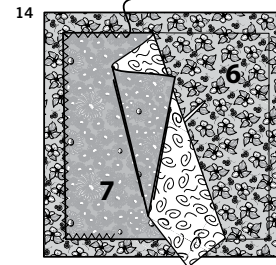
11. Apply paper back fusible web to wrong side of outer applique (5) sections following manufacturer's instructions. Pin applique to front of each petal, over the slit having raw edges along placement lines. Press. Stitch along raw edges of applique through all thicknesses, using a wide zig-zag stitch.



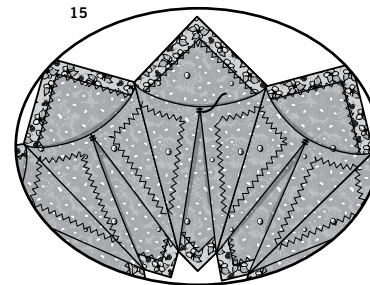
12. Pin back side of outer petals together, matching stitching lines, and having finished edges even; completing a full circle of twelve petals. Stitch on stitching line through all thicknesses.



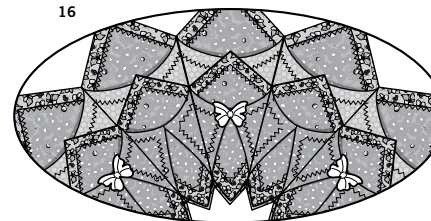
13. On the front, bring side points of each petal together, forming cone-like shapes. Tack points together.



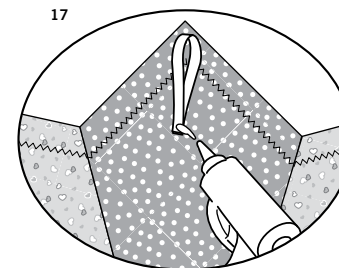
14. Prepare inner petal (6) in the same manner as outer petal. Prepare and apply inner applique (7) in the same manner as outer applique.



15. Stitch back side of inner petals together, completing a full circle of twelve inner petals. Tack the front points in the same manner as the outer petals.



16. With RIGHT sides up, arrange inner ring of petals over outer ring, overlapping finished edges evenly at center opening as shown. Glue layers together at upper and lower edges of inner petals. Glue charms to wreath as shown.



17. **VIEW E OR F** - To form the hanging loop, cut a piece of 1/4" (6mm) wide ribbon 4" (10cm) in length and pin or glue to back of the wreath.
