Suggested Fabrics: Home Dec fabrics such as Broadcloth, Chintz, Cotton Types, Linen Types. **Padding:** Fusible Fleece.

Notions: D: Poly fiberfill. E: 1½ yds. (1.6m) grosgrain ribbon. F,G: ½" (1.3cm) flexible braid: 5¾ yds. (5.2m) for F; 2½ yds. (2.4m) for G.

Cutting Layouts



POSITION OF PATTERN PIECES MAY VARY SLIGHTLY ACCORDING TO YOUR PATTERN SIZE

General Directions For Cutting

PRE-SHRINK and iron all fabric.

FOR DOUBLE THICKNESS -Fold fabric with RIGHT sides together. Pin pattern to WRONG side of fabric.

FOR SINGLE THICKNESS -Pin pattern to RIGHT side of fabric.

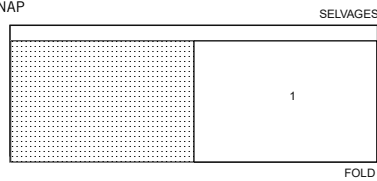
★ If layout shows a piece extending past fold, cut out all pieces except piece that extends. Open out fabric to single thickness. Cut extending piece on RIGHT side of fabric in position shown.

✳ Mark small arrows along both selvages indicating direction of nap or design. Fold fabric crosswise with RIGHT sides together, and cut along fold. Turn one fabric layer around so arrows on both layers go in the same direction. Place RIGHT sides together.

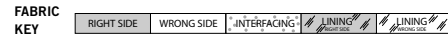


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Sewing Directions

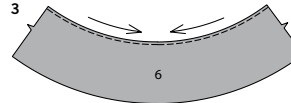
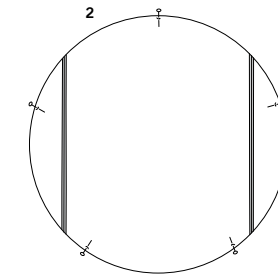
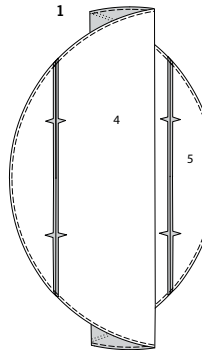
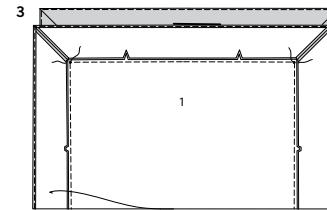
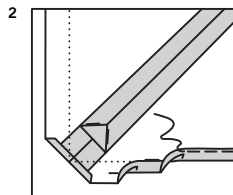
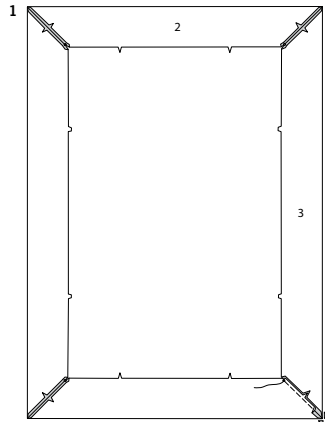
PATTERN PIECES WILL BE IDENTIFIED BY NUMBERS THE FIRST TIME THEY ARE USED.

STITCH IN 1/2" (1.3CM) SEAMS WITH RIGHT SIDES TOGETHER UNLESS OTHERWISE STATED.

TABLECLOTH A

1. To make border, pin top and bottom (2) sections and side band (3) sections together, matching notches, forming one connected piece. Stitch seam as far as small dot, back-stitching at small dot to reinforce seam. Press seams open. Trim points of seam allowances even with tablecloth.

2. Make a 1/2" (1.3cm) **NARROW HEM** on outer edges of border.



3. Pin border to tablecloth (1), matching small dots. Stitch, reinforcing seams at small dots. Press seam toward border.

TABLE TOPPER B, C

1. STAY-STITCH 3/8" (1cm) from outer curved edges of topper (4) and side (5) sections. Stitch side sections to topper, matching notches.

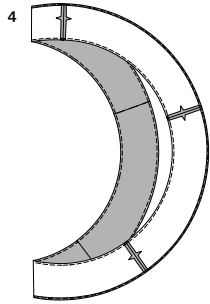

2. To create markings for band seams, divide circumference into five equal sections and mark with pins or a washable fabric marking pen or pencil.

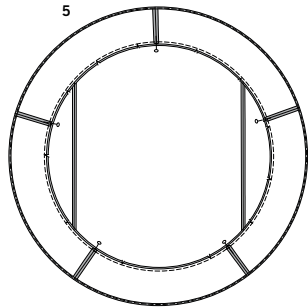
3. Machine-stitch 3/8" (1cm) from upper edge of each band (6) section.

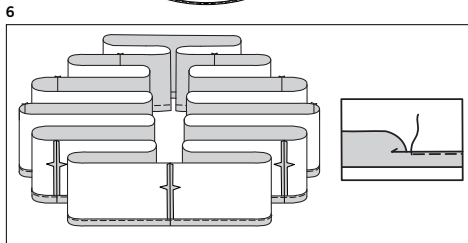


4. Stitch ends of band, forming a circle.
Make a 1/2" (1.3cm) **NARROW HEM** on outer edge .



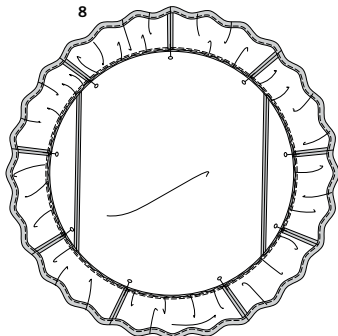
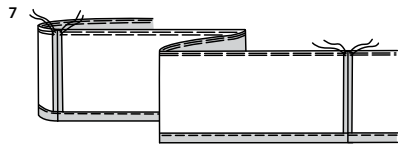
5. Pin band to outer edge of topper, placing seams at markings.
Stitch.
Press seam toward topper, clipping seam allowances where necessary.

CONTINUE A FOLLOWS FOR VIEW C



6. Stitch ends of ruffle (7) sections together, forming a circle.
Press under 2" (5cm) on lower edge. Tuck under inner raw edge to meet crease; press. Stitch close to inner pressed edge.

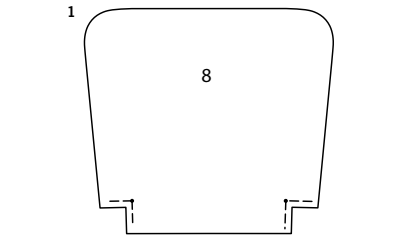
7. **GATHER** upper edge of ruffle.
TIP: If sewing two row gathers, break stitches at seams to make ruffle easier to work with.



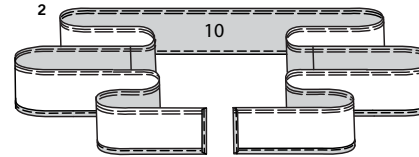
8. Find center edge of table topper. From center, measure and mark circumference in 24" (61cm) intervals. Pin ruffle to outer edge of topper, placing seams at markings. Adjust gathers to fit, distributing fullness evenly. Baste. Stitch.
Press ruffle out, pressing seam toward topper. Clip curves on topper if necessary.

CHAIR PAD D

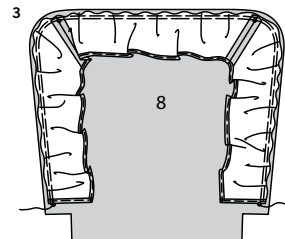
1. **REINFORCE** inner corners of chair pad (8) sections for about 1" (2.5cm) on each side of small dot, pivoting with needle in fabric at small dot.



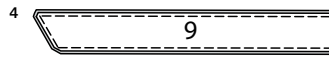
2. Stitch ruffle (10) sections together in two seams, forming one long ruffle.
Make a 1/2" (1.3cm) **NARROW HEM** on side and lower edges.
GATHER upper edge of ruffle.
TIP: If sewing two row gathers, break stitches at seams to make ruffle easier to work with.



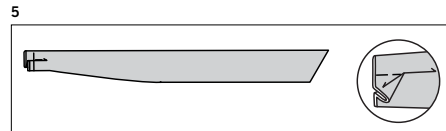
3. With **RIGHT** sides together, pin ruffle to outer edges of chair pad, placing ends at small dots above cut-outs and seams at small dots along curves. Adjust gathering stitches to fit, distributing fullness evenly. Baste.
TIP: To avoid catching in free edges of ruffle in a later step, pin them away from seam allowances.



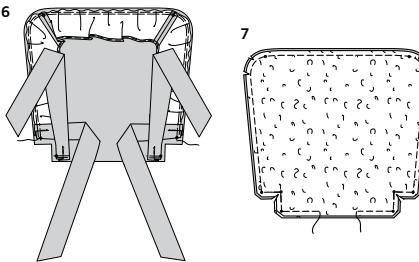
4. For each tie, sew two ties (9) sections together in a 1/4" (6mm) seam, leaving ends with small dots open.
Trim corners.



5. Turn tie **RIGHT** side out. Press. To make pleat, on **OUTSIDE**, fold along solid line. Bring fold to broken line; pin. Baste across raw edge.

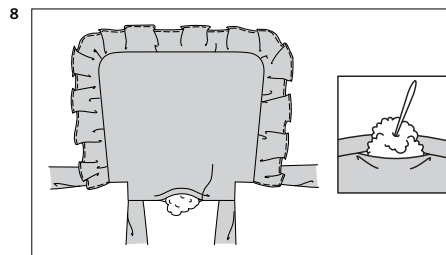


6. On **OUTSIDE**, pin ties to corner edges of chair pad (over ruffle), matching outer small dots, as shown. Baste.



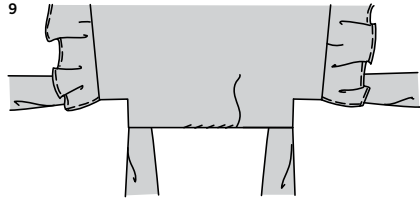
7. Apply fusible fleece interfacing to **WRONG** side of remaining chair pad, following manufacturer's directions.
REINFORCE inner corners same as for pad with attached ties and ruffle.
Pin chair pads together (encasing ruffle and ties), having raw edges even and matching small dots at inner and outer corners. Stitch, pivoting with needle in fabric at small dots at corners, leaving an opening in back for turning and stuffing; be careful not to catch in free edges of ruffle and ties. Back-stitch at ends of opening to reinforce seam.
Trim corners. Clip curves and to stitching at inner corners, being careful not to clip through stitching.

8. Turn chair pad **RIGHT** side out, turning out ruffles and ties. Press. Stuff pad with fiberfill.



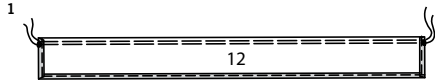
Tips for stuffing:

- Pull fiberfill apart and fluff it before you use it. Break apart the lumps and thick spots
- Use pieces about the size of a tennis ball. Pack into place using the end of a long handled wooden spoon. Use a chopstick or crochet hook to pack in smaller pieces at corners.
- Pack firmly in place each time stuffing is added. Use both hands to mold and shape, being careful not to over stuff or make lopsided.

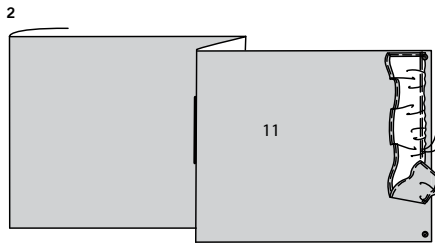


9. SLIP-STITCH opening closed.

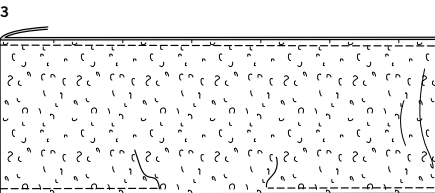
TABLE RUNNER E



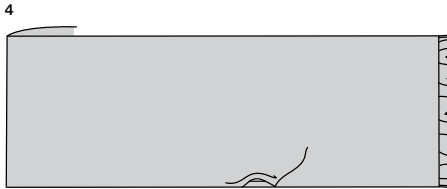
1. Make a 1/2" (1.3cm) **NARROW HEM** at lower and side edges of ruffle (12) sections.
GATHER upper edge of edge between large dot.



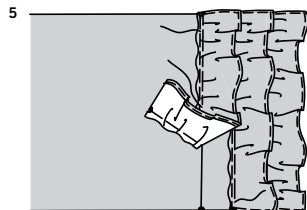
2. With **RIGHT** sides together and raw edges even, pin one ruffle to each end of table runner (11), matching large dots. Pull up gathers to fit, distributing fullness evenly; baste.
TIP- Pin finished ends of ruffle away from seam allowance so they don't get caught in the seam when stitching outer edges.



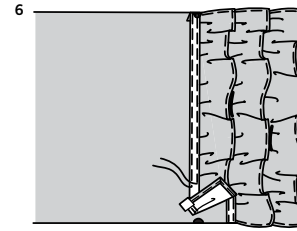
3. Apply fusible fleece to **WRONG** side of remaining runner section, following manufacturer's directions. Pin runner sections together, having raw edges even. Stitch along outer edges, leaving an opening in one long edge for turning. Back-stitch at ends of opening to reinforce seam. Be careful not to catch free edges of ruffle in side seams. Trim corners.



4. Turn runner **RIGHT** side out, turning out ruffles; press.
SLIP-STITCH opening closed.

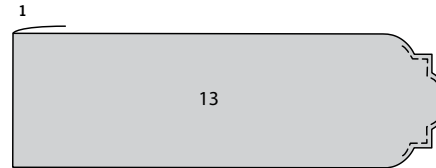


5. With **RIGHT** sides facing up towards you, pin remaining ruffles to runner matching large dots, having raw edges facing toward center and seam lines along placement lines. Pull up gathers to fit; baste to within 3/4" (2cm) of each end.

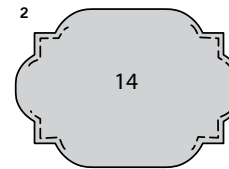


6. Cut four pieces of ribbon trim, each the width of runner, plus 1-1/4" (3.2cm) for seam allowance. On **OUTSIDE**, pin one ribbon over each of the remaining ruffles, extending ends 5/8" (1.5cm) beyond side edges and having long outer edges just covering lower gathering stitches. Turn ends of ribbon over ruffle (sandwiching ends between ruffle and **TOPSIDE** of runner) and pin remainder of ruffle and ribbon in place. Stitch close to long edges of ribbon through all thicknesses. If you prefer, **SLIP-STITCH** ends of ribbon to runner.

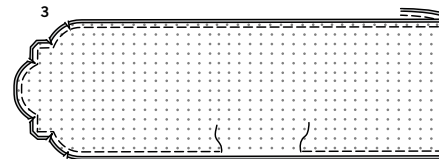
TABLE RUNNER AND/OR PLACEMAT G



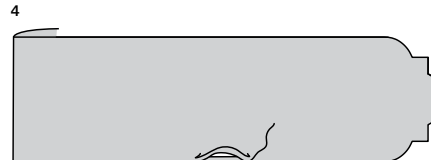
1. **FOR VIEW F- REINFORCE** corners of table runner (13), starting and stopping about 1" (2.5cm) away from each inner corner, as shown, pivoting with needle in fabric at corners.
TIP - Using a washable fabric marking pen or pencil, mark a small dot at each corner along seam line to use as pivot points when stitching.



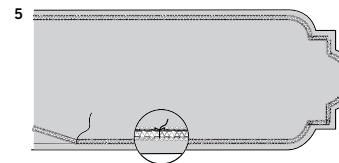
2. **FOR VIEW G- REINFORCE** corners of placemat (14), starting and stopping about 1" (2.5cm) away from each inner corner, as shown, pivoting with needle in fabric at corners.
TIP - Using a washable fabric marking pen or pencil, mark a small dot at each corner along seam line to use as pivot points when stitching.



3. **FOR VIEWS F AND G-** Apply fusible fleece interfacing to **WRONG** side remaining section(s), following manufacturer's directions. Pin non-interfaced section to interfaced section along outer edges, having raw edges even. Stitch, pivoting with needle in fabric at corners and leaving an opening in one long edge for turning. Back-stitch at ends of opening to reinforce seam. Trim seams and corners. Clip curves and to inner corners, being careful not to clip through stitching.

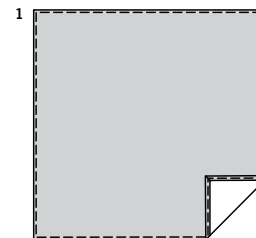


4. Turn runner **RIGHT** side out; press.
SLIP-STITCH opening closed.



5. Carefully pin outer edge of flexible trim along placement line, easing in fullness along curves and folding in fullness at corners, turning under and lapping one end at one outer corner. Stitch close to long edges, pivoting at corners. If necessary, **SLIP-STITCH** ends of trim together.
TIP- If trim is too heavy to lap, turn under each end, having ends meet.
SLIP-STITCH ends together.

NAPKIN H



1. **NARROW HEM** outer edges of each napkin (15) section.
