Suggested Fabrics: Low Pile Faux Fur, Minky Fleece, Plush Fleece. **Contrast Faces A,B,C,D, Ear Appliqués B, Blanket A,B,C,D,E,F:** Fleece. **Nose Appliqué A,D,E:** Synthetic Leather, Synthetic Suede. **Interfacing A,B,C,D:** Lightweight Fusible.

Notions: All Views: Polyfiberfill, pair of 15mm safety eyes, 1 1/4 yd. (1.3m) of 1 1/2" (4cm) ribbon. **Also for A,D:** Fabric glue. **B,C,E:** Six strand embroidery floss. **F:** One 15mm safety nose.

Cutting Layouts



POSITION OF PATTERN PIECES MAY VARY SLIGHTLY ACCORDING TO YOUR PATTERN SIZE

General Directions For Cutting

PRE-SHRINK and iron all fabric.

FOR DOUBLE THICKNESS -Fold fabric with RIGHT sides together. Pin pattern to WRONG side of fabric.

FOR SINGLE THICKNESS -Pin pattern to RIGHT side of fabric.


★ If layout shows a piece extending past fold, cut out all pieces except piece that extends. Open out fabric to single thickness. Cut extending piece on RIGHT side of fabric in position shown.

✱ Mark small arrows along both selvages indicating direction of nap or design. Fold fabric crosswise with RIGHT sides together, and cut along fold. Turn one fabric layer around so arrows on both layers go in the same direction. Place RIGHT sides together.

SIMPLY THE BEST TECHNIQUES FOR...
SEWING FLEECE

- When pinning pieces together, use long pins...the kind with bead heads are best because short pins tend to get lost in the fleece.
- Use a ball point needle. When stitching, try using a narrow zig-zag stitch, adjusting the width and length for the type of fleece you are using. Always test first on some scraps and keep for reference.
- Sew slowly and carefully the first time you stitch a seam as stitches are hard to remove.
- When sewing around shaped areas sew slowly being careful not to stretch the fleece as you feed fabric through your machine.
- Finger press or steam press on a low temperature setting using a press cloth.


FUR FABRICS

- When pinning pieces together, use long pins...the kind with bead heads are best because short pins tend to get lost in the fur.
- Never place iron directly on fur fabric. Press on WRONG side, using a velvet board and cloth.
- On OUTSIDE, with a pin, pick the pile up along the seams.




GENERAL DIRECTIONS FOR...

ATTACHING SAFETY EYES


To attach each eye, using a sharp pointed object or an awl, poke a hole at small dots. Insert the eye or nose shank through the opening from OUTSIDE and secure in place with washer on INSIDE making sure it is on securely.

STUFFING

Pull fiberfill apart and fluff it before you use it. Break apart lumps and thick spots. This will help create a smooth looking project. Use pieces about the size of a tennis ball. Pack into place using the end of a long handled wooden spoon or chopstick. For smaller sections, use small pieces and pack into place using the end of a crochet hook or chopstick. Pack firmly in place each time stuffing is added. Use both hands to mold and shape, being careful not to over stuff or make lopsided.



PATTERN PIECES WILL BE IDENTIFIED BY NUMBERS THE FIRST TIME THEY ARE USED.

STITCH IN 1/2" (1.3CM) SEAMS WITH RIGHT SIDES TOGETHER UNLESS OTHERWISE STATED.

BEAR A, E

- FOR VIEW A**- Apply interfacing to WRONG side of face applique (2) following manufacturer's directions. On OUTSIDE, pin applique to front (1), having inner edges along broken placement lines and outer raw edges even. Baste raw edges together. Zigzag applique in place along inner raw edges.
- FOR VIEW E**- To reinforce front (1) sections for safety eyes, cut two 1" (2.5cm) circles from remnants of fusible interfacing. Fuse to WRONG side of front over small dots for eyes, following manufacturer's directions.





- FOR VIEWS A, E** - Stitch center front seam of front sections, matching double notches. Clip curves.
- Cut nose applique (4) tissue block along outer solid line. Cut out applique. Glue nose to face over center front seam, having outer edges along broken lines. Insert safety eyes at small dots; see **GENERAL DIRECTIONS FOR ATTACHING SAFETY EYES**.
- To stitch **DART** seam in back (3) sections, With **RIGHT** sides together and raw edges even, bring broken dart lines together, carefully matching small dots. Stitch **DART** seam. Press seam toward center back. Stitch center back seam of back sections together, leaving seam open between notches, back-stitching at notches to reinforce seam.
- Pin back to front along outer edges, matching seams and small dots, having raw edges even. Stitch, pivoting with needle in fabric at small dots. **REINFORCE** inner corners and sharp curves. Clip curves and to stitching at small dots, being careful not to cut through stitching.
- Turn bear **RIGHT** side out. Finger press ears and then lightly stuff, extending stuffing about 1/2" (1.3cm) beyond small dots. See **GENERAL DIRECTIONS FOR STUFFING**. Machine-stitch along stitching line between small dots, separating ears from body.
- Firmly stuff head, turning it all angles to shape. Stuff remainder of body. See **GENERAL DIRECTIONS FOR STUFFING**. **SLIPSTITCH** opening closed. **TIP** - If you prefer, reduce fiberfill to almost nothing at inner arm and leg joints, enabling you to position bear in a sitting position with arms and legs facing forward. Invisibly hand-tack bottom of each arm to corresponding foot allowing the arm to rest on the foot.
- Cut ribbon approximately 40" (102cm), notching out ends as shown. Tie ribbon around neck and fasten in a bow at one side.

BUNNY B

- Apply interfacing to **WRONG** side of face applique (6). On **OUTSIDE**, pin applique to front, having inner edges along placement lines and outer raw edges even. Baste raw edges together. Zigzag applique in place along inner raw edges.
- Apply interfacing to **WRONG** side of applique fabric for inner ear applique (7) sections, following manufacturer's directions. Cut applique tissue block along outer solid line. Pin pattern to **RIGHT** side of prepared fabric. Cut out each applique. Transfer markings to **RIGHT** side of applique using a washable fabric marking pen or pencil.
- To make pleat in ear applique, on **UNDERSIDE**, bring broken lines together. Stitch along broken lines. Finger-press pleat flat, bringing stitching to center. Hand-baste across raw edge. Pin **WRONG** side of applique to front, having outer edges along broken lines. Zigzag in place along inner raw edges. Apply safety eye at small dots; see **GENERAL DIRECTIONS FOR ATTACHING SAFETY EYES**.



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4. Stitch center front seam of front sections, matching double notches.
Clip curves.

5. Embroider muzzle, as follows:
Thread a large-eyed needle with embroidery floss. Make a long running stitch between small dots on center front seam and then vertically to outer small dots, as shown. Finish with a horizontal stitch below lower small dot at center front, making it about 1/2" (1.3cm) long or longer, as desired.



6. To stitch **DART** seam in back (8) sections, With **RIGHT** sides together and raw edges even, bring broken dart lines together, carefully matching small dots. Stitch **DART** seam.
Press seam toward center back.
Stitch center back seam of back sections together, leaving seam open between notches, back-stitching at notches to reinforce seam.

7. Pin back to front along outer edges, matching seams and small dots, having raw edges even. Stitch, pivoting with needle in fabric at small dots.
REINFORCE inner corners and sharp curves.
Clip curves and to stitching at small dots, being careful not to cut through stitching.


8. Turn bunny **RIGHT** side out.
Finger press ears and then lightly stuff, extending stuffing about 1/2" (1.3cm) beyond small dots. See **GENERAL DIRECTIONS FOR STUFFING**.

Machine-stitch along stitching line between small dots, separating ears from body.
Firmly stuff head, turning it all angles to shape.
Stuff remainder of body. See **GENERAL DIRECTIONS FOR STUFFING**.
SLIPSTITCH opening closed.
TIP - If you prefer, reduce fiberfill to almost nothing at inner arm and leg joints, enabling you to position bear in a sitting position with arms and legs facing forward. Invisibly hand-tack bottom of each arm to corresponding foot allowing the arm to rest on the foot.

9. Apply makeup blush or chalk to a remnant of soft cloth and dab or swirl over cheeks. You can also use a crayon; apply slowly, building up to desirable depth.
Cut ribbon approximately 40" (102cm), notching out ends as shown.
Tie ribbon around neck and fasten in a bow at one side.


KITTY C

1. Apply interfacing to **WRONG** side of face applique (10), following manufacturer's directions.
On **OUTSIDE**, pin applique to front (9), having inner raw edges along broken placement lines and outer raw edges even.
Baste raw edges together.
Zigzag face in place along inner raw edges.




2. Stitch center front seam of front sections, matching double notches.
Clip curves.


3. Embroider muzzle, as follows:
Thread a large-eyed needle with embroidery floss.
To embroider nose, make a long running stitch diagonally between small dots closest to seam, crisscrossing at center front, as shown.
To form whiskers, make three horizontal rows of small, evenly spaced running stitches on each side of center front between remaining small dots.
Apply safety eye at small dots; see **GENERAL DIRECTIONS FOR ATTACHING SAFETY EYES**.




4. To stitch **DART** seam in back (11) sections, With **RIGHT** sides together and raw edges even, bring broken dart lines together, carefully matching small dots. Stitch **DART** seam.
Press seam toward center back.
Stitch center back seam of back sections together, leaving seam open between notches, back-stitching at notches to reinforce seam.




5. Pin back to front along outer edges, matching seams and small dots, having raw edges even. Stitch, pivoting with needle in fabric at small dots and at corners or ears.
REINFORCE ears, inner corners and sharp curve.
Clip curves and to stitching at small dots, being careful not to cut through stitching.
Trim ears at outer corners.








6. Turn kitty. **RIGHT** side out.
Finger press ears and then lightly stuff, extending stuffing about 1/2" (1.3cm) beyond small dots. See **GENERAL DIRECTIONS FOR STUFFING**.
Machine-stitch along stitching line between small dots, separating ears from body.
Firmly stuff head, turning it all angles to shape.
Stuff remainder of body.
SLIPSTITCH opening closed.
TIP - If you prefer, reduce fiberfill to almost nothing at inner arm and leg joints, enabling you to position bear in a sitting position with arms and legs facing forward. Invisibly hand-tack bottom of each arm to corresponding foot allowing the arm to rest on the foot.



7. Cut ribbon approximately 40" (102cm), notching out ends as shown.
Tie ribbon around neck and fasten in a bow at one side.



PUPPY D, F



1. FOR VIEW D- Apply interfacing to WRONG side of face applique (13). Fuse in place, following manufacturer's directions. On OUTSIDE, pin applique to front (12), having inner raw edges along broken placement lines and outer raw edges even. Baste raw edges together. Zigzag in place along inner raw edges.

2. FOR VIEW F - To reinforce front (13) sections for safety eyes, cut 1" (2.5cm) circles from remnants of fusible interfacing. Fuse circles to WRONG side of front underneath small dots for eyes, following manufacturer's directions.



3. Stitch center front seam of front sections, matching double notches. Clip curves.

4. FOR VIEW D- Cut nose applique (15) tissue block along outer solid line. Cut out applique. Glue to face over center front seam, having outer edges along broken lines. Insert safety eyes at small dots; see **GENERAL DIRECTIONS FOR ATTACHING SAFETY EYES**.

5. FOR VIEW F- Insert safety eyes and nose at corresponding small dots; see **GENERAL DIRECTIONS FOR ATTACHING SAFETY EYES/NOSE**.

6. FOR VIEWS D, F -To stitch **DART** seam in back (14) sections, With **RIGHT** sides together and raw edges even, bring broken dart lines together, carefully matching small dots. Stitch **DART** seam. Press seam toward center back. Stitch center back seam of back sections together, leaving seam open between notches, back-stitching at notches to reinforce seam.

7. Pin back to front along outer edges, matching seams and small dots, having raw edges even. Stitch, pivoting with needle in fabric at small dots. **REINFORCE** seam at small dots on inner corners and sharp curves. Clip curves and to stitching at small dots, being careful not to cut through stitching.



8. Turn puppy **RIGHT** side out. Finger press ears and then lightly stuff, extending stuffing about 1/2" (1.3cm) beyond small dots. See **GENERAL DIRECTIONS FOR STUFFING**.



Machine-stitch along stitching line between small dots, separating ears from body. Firmly stuff head, turning it all angles to shape. Stuff remainder of body.

SLIPSTITCH opening closed.

TIP - If you prefer, reduce fiberfill to almost nothing at inner arm and leg joints, enabling you to position bear in a sitting position with arms and legs facing forward. Invisibly hand-tack bottom of each arm to corresponding foot allowing the arm to rest on the foot.

9. Cut ribbon approximately 40" (102cm), notching out ends as shown. Tie ribbon around neck and fasten in a bow at one side.

BLANKET A, B, C, D, E, F



1. To miter ends of blanket (16), fold corners in half, having **RIGHT** sides together and raw edges even, as shown. Stitch ends in 1/4" (6mm) seams. **REINFORCE** seams.

2. Clip along each fold, being careful not to clip through stitching. Lightly or finger-press seams open.

3. Turn ends to **INSIDE**. Press, pressing under 3/4" (2cm) hem allowance on outer edges. Pin hem in place. To mark ends for hem stitching, using a washable marking pen or pencil and a clear ruler, mark a line 1/2" (1.3cm) in from hemmed edges on each corner, as shown. Machine-stitch 1/2" (1.3cm) from fold edges, pivoting where your marked lines intersect.
