**PLUSH DOLLS WITH CLOTHES AND PLUSH PETS**

**Suggested Fabrics:** A,B,C in Broadcloth, Chambray, Cotton Types, Linen Types, Quilting Cottons. D,E,F in Fleece. **Eye Back, Eye and Pupil Appliqués A,B,C,D,E,F, Leaf Appliqués A,B,C, Hair and Shoes Appliqués D,E,F, Nose Appliqué F** in Felt. **Interfacing A,B,C:** Lightweight Fusible.

**Notions:** A,B,C,D,E,F: Polyfill, embroidery floss or paint, fabric glue, pair of 3/8" (3mm) flat back round iron-on beads (for eyes). **Also for A,B,C:** Hank yarn (for hair), 1/2 yd. (0.5m) of 1/4" (6mm) ribbon, two 1" (2.5cm) embroidered flowers. **Also for A,B:** 1 1/4 yds. (1.2m) of 1" - 1 1/2" (2.5cm - 4cm) ribbon, 1 1/2 yd. (1.3m) of 1/4" (6mm) elastic, 1 1/2" (4cm) length of 1/2" (1.3cm) hook and loop tape, 1 1/4 yd. (1.1m) of 1 1/4" (3cm) pre-gathered eyelet trim. **Also for C:** 1 1/4 yds. (1.2m) of 1" - 1 1/2" (2.5cm - 4cm) ribbon, 1 1/2 yd. (1.3m) of 1/4" (6mm) elastic. **D,E,F:** 1/2 yd. (0.5m) of 1/2" (1.3cm) foldover elastic, 10" (25cm) length of medium weight chain, one 1" (2.5cm) embroidered flower.

## Cutting Layouts



POSITION OF PATTERN PIECES MAY VARY  
SLIGHTLY ACCORDING TO YOUR PATTERN SIZE

### General Directions For Cutting

**PRE-SHRINK** and iron all fabric.

**FOR DOUBLE THICKNESS** -Fold fabric with **RIGHT** sides together. Pin pattern to **WRONG** side of fabric.

**FOR SINGLE THICKNESS** -Pin pattern to **RIGHT** side of fabric.

★ If layout shows a piece extending past fold, cut out all pieces except piece that extends. Open out fabric to single thickness. Cut extending piece on **RIGHT** side of fabric in position shown.

✳ Mark small arrows along both selvages in dicing direction of nap or design. Fold fabric crosswise with **RIGHT** sides together, and cut along fold. Turn one fabric layer around so arrows on both layers go in the same direction. Place **RIGHT** sides together.

## Sewing Directions



Read **General Directions** on page 1 before you begin.

Sewing methods in **BOLD TYPE** have Sewing Tutorial Video available. Scan QR CODE to watch videos:

**CATCH STITCH** – see **Hand Stitching**: “hand sewing a catch stitch” video.

**EDGE STITCH** – see **Machine Stitches**: “how to sew an edgestitch” video.

**SLIP STITCH** – see **Hand Stitching**: “how to slip stitch” video.

**TRIM SEAM** – see **Seams**: “how to trim, clip and layer seams” video.

## GLOSSARY OF SEWING METHODS

Sewing methods shown in **BOLD ITALICS** are defined below:

**APPLY APPLIQUÉ** – Pin appliqué(s) to project as instructed in Sewing Directions. Be sure to clear all seam allowances. Fuse appliqué(s) in place, following manufacturer's directions.

**GATHER** – Loosen needle tension slightly. With **RIGHT** side up, stitch 1/4" (6mm) from cut edge using a long stitch. Stitch again 1/8" (3mm) from the first stitching within the seam allowance.

**PREPARE APPLIQUÉ** – Apply paper backed fusible web to wrong side of appliqué fabric following manufacturer's directions, as needed. Cut appliqué tissue block along outer solid line. Pin pattern to right side of prepared fabric. Cut out each appliqué. Transfer markings to right side of appliqué using a washable fabric marking pen or pencil.

**STUFF** – Pull fiberfill apart and fluff it, breaking apart lumps and thick spots. Use pieces about the size of a golf ball. Pack into place using the end of a long handled wooden spoon or chopstick. Pack firmly in place each time stuffing is added. Use both hands to mold and shape, being careful not to over stuff or make lopsided.

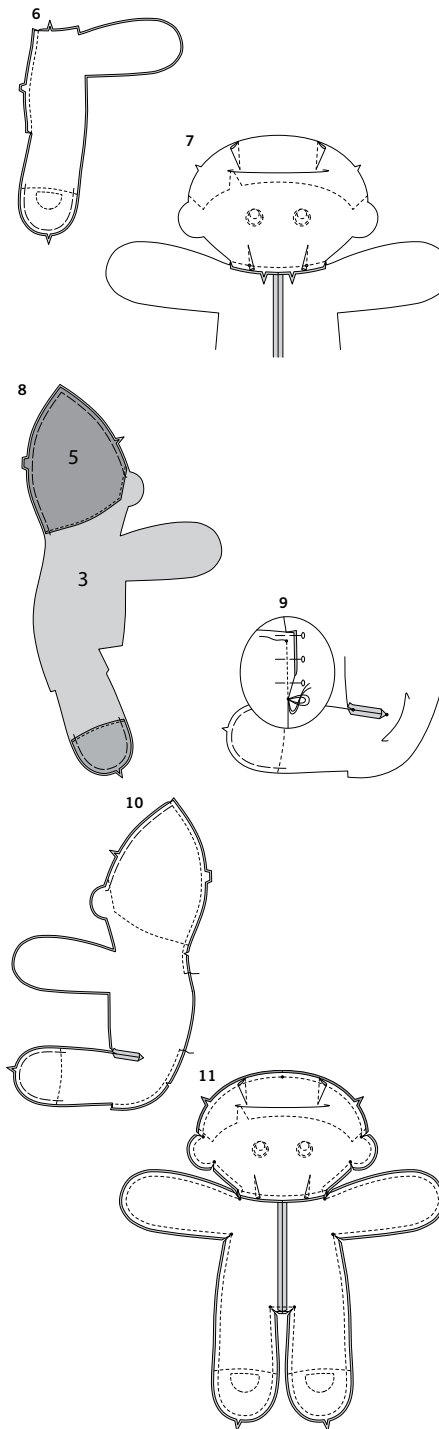
**PATTERN PIECES WILL BE IDENTIFIED BY NUMBERS THE FIRST TIME THEY ARE USED.**

**STITCH 1/4" (6MM) SEAMS WITH RIGHT SIDES TOGETHER UNLESS OTHERWISE STATED.**

## DOLL A, B, C

## DOLL

- PREPARE APPLIQUÉ** FRONT HAIR APPLIQUÉ (4) without paper back fusible web. Pin front hair appliqué to **FACE** (1), matching centers and notches. **EDGE STITCH** inner edge. Baste raw edges together.
- PREPARE APPLIQUÉ** EYE BACK AND PUPIL APPLIQUÉ (6) and **EYE APPLIQUÉ** (7). **APPLY APPLIQUÉ** and **EDGE STITCH** inner edges. Apply pupil to eye; eye to eye back, as shown; eye back to face centered over small dots. Place 1/8" (3mm) flat back round iron-on bead to pupil, as shown, or as desired. Press.
- To make a French knot for mouth at small dot on face, work with as many threads as desired and use a large eyed needle. Bring thread to right side at A; hold thread with thumb and forefinger in opposite hand; wind thread around the needle two or three times. Hold thread down with thumb, and put needle into fabric close to A, but not in the same hole. Pull to wrong side, drawing up thread to form French Knot.
- Make **FLAT DART**(s) on upper and lower edges of face, pressing darts away from center.
- PREPARE APPLIQUÉ** SHOE APPLIQUÉ (8) without paper back fusible web, removing cut out on shoe front sections. Pin front shoe appliqué to **BODY FRONT** (2), matching notches. **EDGE STITCH** inner edges. Baste raw edges together.



6. Stitch center front seam of body front.

7. With right sides together and raw edges even, pin face to body front, matching small dots and notches. Stitch. Press seam toward body front.

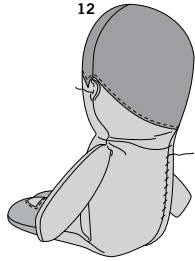
8. **PREPARE APPLIQUÉ** BACK HAIR APPLIQUÉ (5) without paper back fusible web. Pin hair back appliqué and shoe back appliqué to **BODY BACK** (3), matching notches. **EDGE STITCH** inner edges. Baste raw edges together.

9. To make dart seam on lower back edges of body back, with right sides together, bring broken lines together, matching small dots. Stitch along broken line between the dots from wide end to point, backstitching at outer dot to reinforce the seam. Press dart seam open.

10. Stitch center back edges of body back sections together, leaving an opening in middle of back for turning. **TRIM SEAM.**

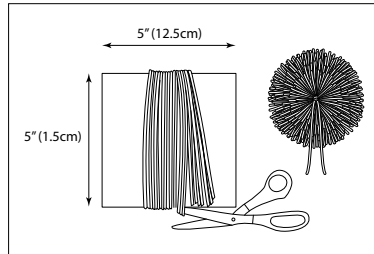
11. Pin body front to body back at side edges, matching small dots and notches. Stitch, pivoting with needle in fabric at small dots. Clip to stitching at dots, being careful not to clip through stitching. **TRIM SEAM.** (Clip seam sparingly as clipping will weaken the seam.)

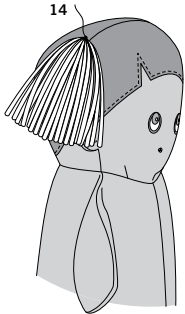
12. Turn body; press. **STUFF. SLIPSTITCH** opening closed. To form ear, on outside, stitch along stitching line.

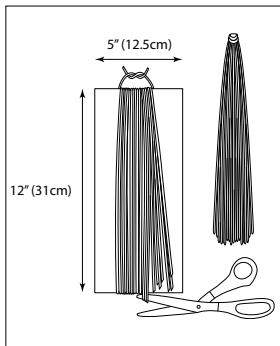
13. **FOR VIEW A** – For each pigtail, cut a piece of cardboard 5" (12.5cm) long and 5" (12.5cm) wide. Wrap yarn around cardboard one hundred times or until the desired fullness. Cut a strand of yarn 4" (10cm) long. Slip yarn under the loops along one long edge and fasten securely. Cut through loops on remaining edge. Roll between hands to fluff pom-pom.

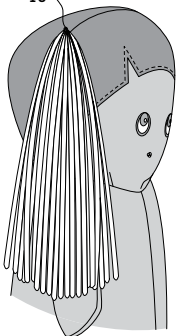
14. On outside, tack each pom-pom to back hair and body at small dot.

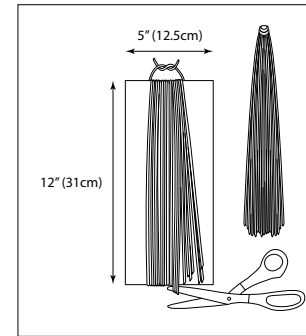
15. **FOR VIEW B** – To make a ponytail, cut a piece of cardboard 5" (12.5cm) long and 12" (31cm) wide. Wrap yarn around cardboard forty times or until the desired fullness. Cut a strand of yarn 4" (10cm) long. Slip yarn under the loops along upper edge and fasten securely. Cut through loops on remaining edge.

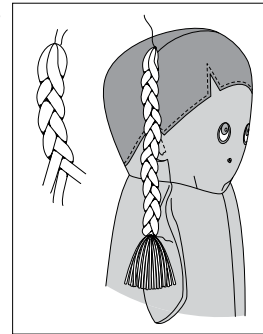
16. On outside, tack ponytail to right side of back hair and body at small dot.

17. **FOR VIEW C** – For each braid, cut a piece of cardboard 5" (12.5cm) long and 12" (31cm) wide. Wrap yarn around cardboard forty times or until the desired fullness. Cut a strand of yarn 4" (10cm) long. Slip yarn under the loops along upper edge and fasten securely. Cut through loops on remaining edge.

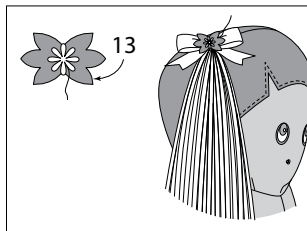
18. Divide yarn strands into three equal sections, and braid from top to 2-1/2" (6.3cm) above bottom. Cut another strand of yarn 4" (10cm) long. Wrap at end of braid, knot, clip, and tuck inside, invisibly. On outside, tack each braid to back hair and body at small dot.

19. **FOR ALL VIEWS** – Cut 1" – 1-1/2" (2.5 – 3.8cm) wide ribbon, 16" (41cm) long. Wrap a piece ribbon around the top of each pigtail, ponytail, or braid, and tie into a bow. Clip ends of ribbon, as shown, or as you prefer.

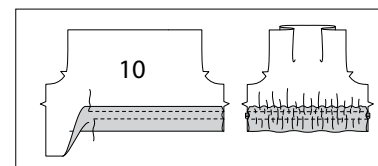
20. **FOR VIEW B – PREPARE APPLIQUÉ LEAF APPLIQUÉ** (13), two, without paper back fusible web. Pin 1" (2.5) embroidered flower to center of leaf. Tack in place. Pin leaf to ribbon over knot. Hand tack or adhere with fabric glue. (The second leaf and flower construction will be used on collar in a separate step.)

## DOLL CLOTHES A, B, C

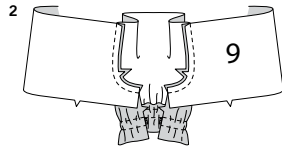
**NOTE:** If you prefer, finish raw edges of garments with a zigzag stitch.

### BODICE

1



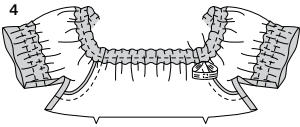
1. Press up lower edge of SLEEVE (10) along foldline. To make casing for elastic, stitch 1/4" (6mm) from raw edge, and again 3/8" (1cm) from first stitching. Cut a piece of 1/4" (6mm) wide elastic 6" (15cm) long. Thread elastic through casing. Stitch across ends, securely.



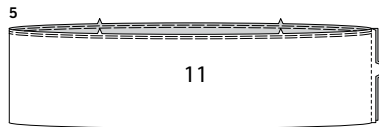
2. With right sides together and raw edges even, pin sleeves to BODICE FRONT AND BACK (9) sections. Stitch. Press seam toward sleeve.



3. Stitch front to back at entire underarm seam, matching armhole seams.

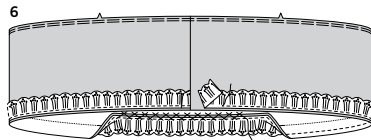


4. Press under neck edge of bodice and sleeve along foldline. Stitch  $1/4$ " (6mm) from raw edge, leaving an opening to insert elastic. Cut a piece of  $1/4$ " (6mm) wide elastic 15" (38cm) long. Thread elastic through opening in casing. Lap ends  $1/4$ " (6mm) and stitch together, securely. Stitch opening closed.

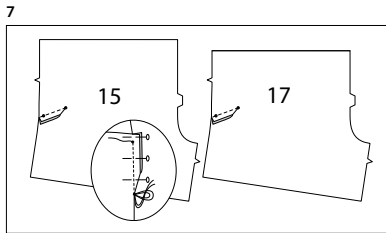


### SKIRT A, B

5. **GATHER** upper edge of SKIRT FRONT AND BACK (11) between center back seamlines. Stitch center back edges together.

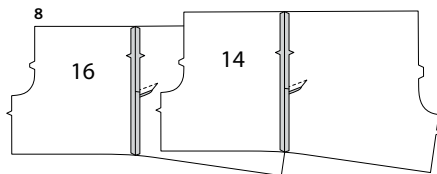


6. On outside, pin wrong side of 1- $1/4$ " (3.2) wide pre-gathered lace or eyelet to lower edge of skirt, placing straight edge of trim  $1/8$ " (3mm) from raw edge, turning under and lapping ends at center back seam. Stitch close to straight edge of lace. Turn under lower edge of skirt  $3/4$ " (2cm). Press, pressing up hem and pressing out trim. **CATCH STITCH** hem in place.

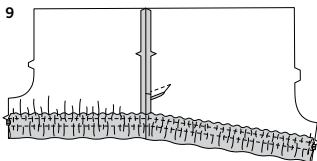


### PANTALOONS A, B; JUMPSUIT PANTS C

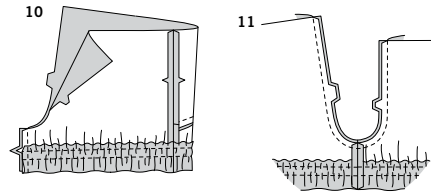
7. To make dart seam on side edge of PANTALOONS BACK (15) or PANTS BACK (17), with right sides together, bring broken lines together, matching small dots. Stitch along broken line between the dots from wide end to point, backstitching at outer dot to reinforce the seam. Press dart seam toward leg.



8. Stitch pantaloons back to PANTALOONS FRONT (14) or pants back to PANTS FRONT (16) at side edges.

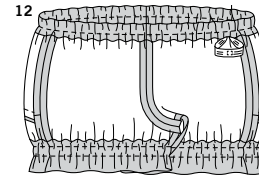


9. Press up lower edge of pantaloons or pants along foldline. To make casing for elastic, stitch  $1/4$ " (6mm) from raw edge, and again  $3/8$ " (1cm) from first stitching. Cut a piece of  $1/4$ " (6mm) wide elastic 8" (21cm) long. Thread elastic through casing. Stitch across ends, securely.

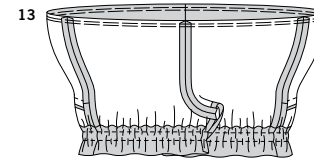


10. Stitch inner leg edges together.

11. Stitch front to back at center edges.

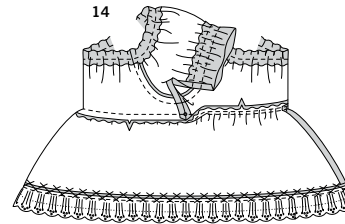


12. **FOR PANTALOONS A, B** – Press under upper edge of pantaloons along foldline. Stitch  $1/4$ " (6mm) from raw edge, leaving an opening to insert elastic. Cut a piece of  $1/4$ " (6mm) wide elastic 14 -  $1/4$ " (36.5cm) long. Thread elastic through opening in casing. Lap ends  $1/4$ " (6mm) and stitch together, securely. Stitch opening closed.

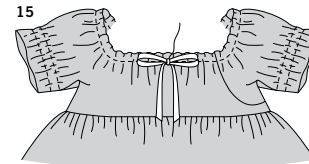


13. **FOR JUMPSUIT PANTS C** – **GATHER** upper edge of pants.

### CONTINUE AS FOLLOWS FOR DRESS A, B; JUMPSUIT C

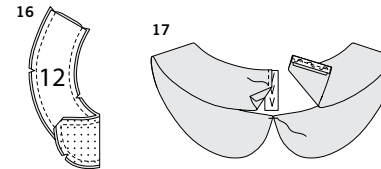


14. With right sides together and raw edges even, pin skirt or pants to bodice, matching centers, and notches, placing small dots at side seams, pulling up gathering stitches to fit. Stitch. Stitch again close to first stitching within the seam allowance. Press seam toward bodice.

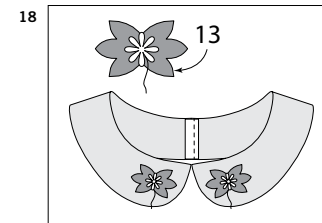


15. Turn garment; press. Cut a piece of  $1/4$ " (6mm) wide ribbon 15" (38cm) long. Tie into a bow. Trim ends, as shown or as you prefer. Tack knot of ribbon to neck edge of bodice at center front along stitching.

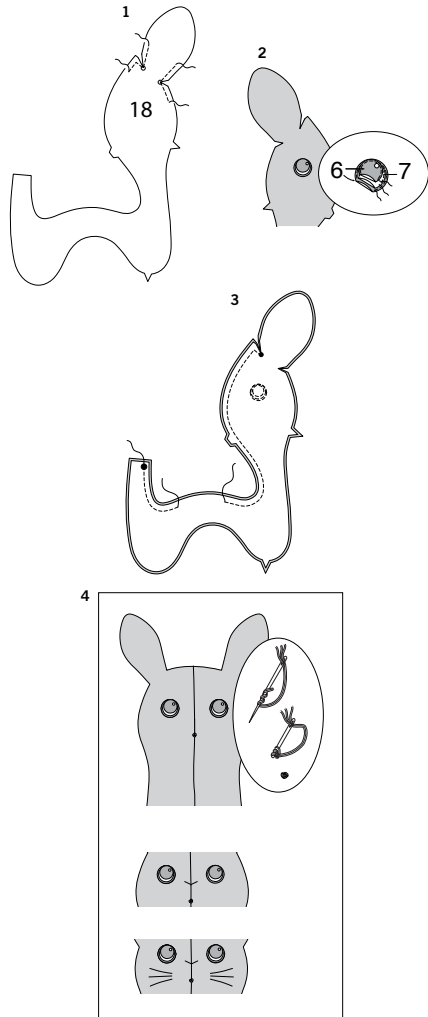
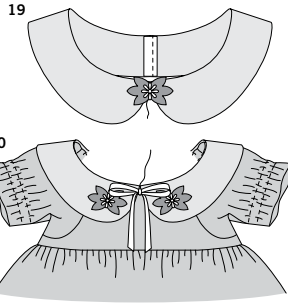
16. Pin interfacing to wrong side of COLLAR (12). Fuse interfacing in place following manufacturer's directions. Pin facing to collar with right sides together. Stitch, leaving back edges open. **TRIM SEAM.**



17. Turn collar; press, pressing under back opening edges along seamline. Tack collar section together at center front neck edge. Cut a piece of  $1/2$ " (1.3cm) hook and loop tape 1- $1/2$ " (3.8cm) long. Separate the tape. Cut loop section **ONLY** of tape in half, lengthwise. On inside, pin loop section to right back having outer edge even with pressed edge of opening. Stitch  $1/8$ " (3mm) from pressed edge. Lap left pressed edge of back opening over hook section of tape  $1/4$ " (6mm). Stitch in place  $1/8$ " (3mm) from pressed edge.



18. **FOR VIEW A, C** – **PREPARE APPLIQUÉ LEAF APPLIQUÉ** (13), without paper back fusible web. Pin 1" (2.5) embroidered flower to center of each leaf. Tack in place. Pin leaves to collar over small dots. Hand tack.



19. **FOR VIEW B** – Pin remaining leaf and flower construction to collar lapping center front and neck edges, as shown. Tack in place.

20. **FOR ALL VIEWS** – Tack collar to center front bodice at neck edge.

### PETS D, E, F

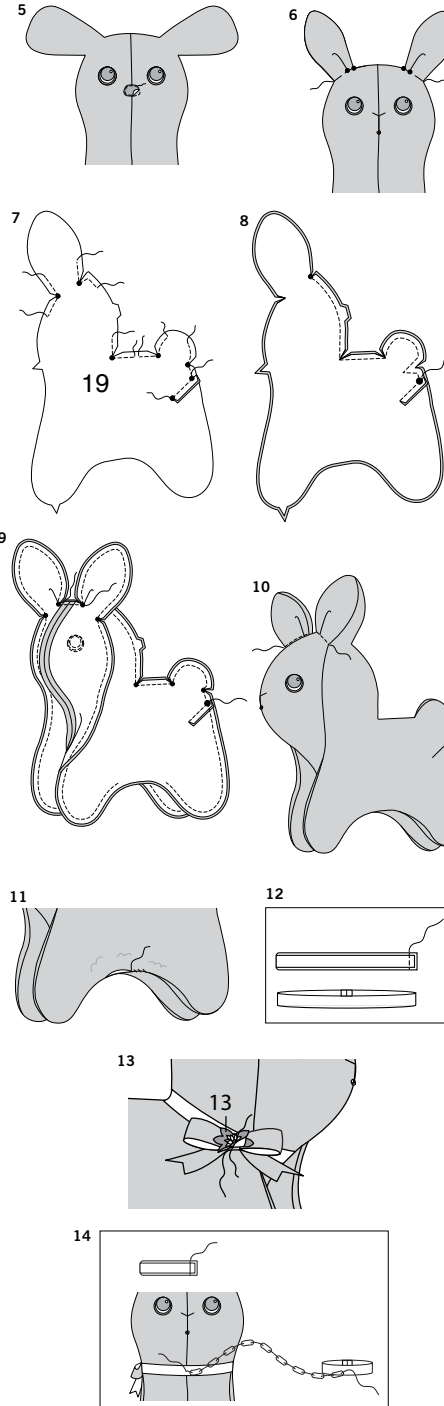
**NOTE:** View D will be illustrated unless otherwise noted.

1. To reinforce upper corners of BODY FRONT (18), BODY FRONT (20), or BODY FRONT (22) sections at small dots, stitch along seam line for about 1" (2.5cm) each side of small dots, stitching through dots, as shown. Clip to stitching at dots.

2. **PREPARE APPLIQUÉ** EYE BACK AND PUPIL APPLIQUÉ (6) and EYE APPLIQUÉ (7). **APPLY APPLIQUÉ** pupil to eye; eye to eye back; eye back to body front over the broken lines. **EDGESTITCH** inner edges. Place 1/8" (3mm) flat back round iron-on bead to pupil, as shown, or as desired. Press.

3. With right sides together and raw edges even, pin center edges of body front sections, matching large dots and double notches. Stitch, leaving an opening in under belly for turning. **TRIM SEAM.**

4. To make mouth on pet, make one long stitch over stitching line, working with as many threads as desired and a large eyed needle, knotting both ends on inside. Make nose for View D, and nose and whiskers for View E in the same manner. For All Views, make a French in knot at lower end of line for mouth. To make a French knot, bring thread to right side at A; hold thread with thumb and forefinger in opposite hand; wind thread around the needle two or three times. Hold thread down with thumb, and put needle into fabric close to A, but not in the same hole. Pull to wrong side, drawing up thread to form French Knot.



5. **FOR VIEW F**– **PREPARE APPLIQUÉ** NOSE APPLIQUÉ (24). **APPLY APPLIQUÉ** nose to body front over the broken lines. **EDGESTITCH** inner edges.

6. **FOR VIEW D** – On outside, bring small dot on front ear edge to small dot at inner ear, forming a tuck. Baste across stitching line.

### CONTINUE AS FOLLOWS FOR ALL VIEWS

7. To reinforce corners at ear, neck, and tail edges of BODY BACK (19), BODY BACK (21), or BODY BACK (23) sections at small dots, stitch along seam line for about 1" (2.5cm) each side of small dots, stitching through dots, as shown. Clip to stitching at dots. Make **FLAT DART** stitching from outer small dot to inner small dot, backstitching at outer dot to reinforce the seam. Press seam away from tail.

8. Stitch center back edges from upper edge to large dot, backstitching at dot to reinforce the seam. **TRIM SEAM.**

9. Pin body front to body back at side edges, matching small dots, large dots, and notches. Stitch one half at a time, from upper edge to large dot, pivoting with needle in fabric at the small dots. **TRIM SEAM.**

10. Turn pet; press. Stitch across stitching lines across ears.

11. **STUFF. SLIPSTITCH** opening closed.

12. To make a collar, cut a piece of 1/2" (1.3cm) foldover elastic to fit neck, plus 1/2" (1.3cm). Stitch ends in a 1/4" (6mm) seam. Turn collar. Stretch collar over neck placing seam to the right side back.

13. Cut a piece of 1" – 1-1/2" (2.5 – 3.8cm) wide ribbon, 16" (41cm) long. Tie ribbon into a bow. Clip ends of ribbon, as shown, or as you prefer. **PREPARE APPLIQUÉ** LEAF APPLIQUÉ (13), without paper back fusible web. Pin 1" (2.5) embroidered flower to center of leaf. Tack in place. Pin leaf to ribbon over knot. Hand tack or adhere with fabric glue. Tack ribbon at knot to seam on collar.

14. To make a strap for leash, cut a piece of 1/2" (1.3cm) foldover elastic 5-1/2" (12.5cm) long. Stitch ends in a 1/4" (6mm) seam. Turn leash. Tack one end of 10" (26cm) long medium weight chain to end of leash, and the other end to collar, centered on elastic at center front.
