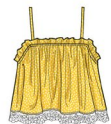

**Notions:** A,B,C: 1½ yds. (1.2m) of ¾" (1cm) elastic. **Also for B,C:** Pair of bra slides and rings. **Also for C:** 2¾ yds. (2.6m) of 1" - 2" (2.5cm - 5cm) wide lace trim.

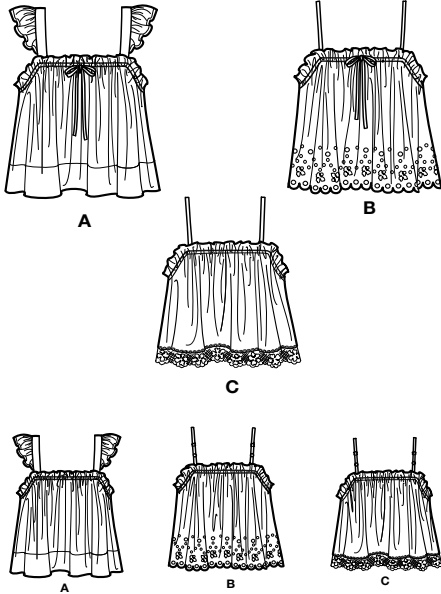

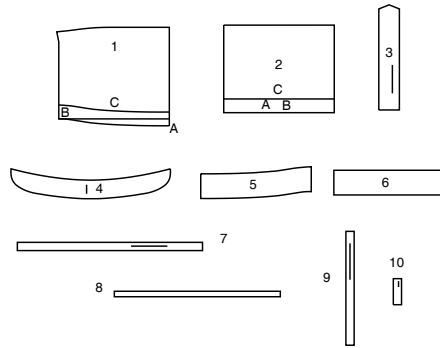

## The Pattern

- SYMBOLS**
- ← → GRAIN LINE Place on straight grain of fabric parallel to selvage
  - ▬ PLACE SOLID LINE on fold of fabric.
  - - - CENTER FRONT OR BACK of garment.
  - ▽ ▽ NOTCHES
  - ○ DOTS
  - CUTTING LINE
  - ▬▬ LENGTHEN OR SHORTEN LINES

SEAM ALLOWANCE: 5/8" (1.5cm) unless otherwise stated is included but not printed on MULTI-SIZE PATTERNS. Mark your size with colored felt tip pen. See chart on tissue for how to use MULTI-SIZE PATTERNS.

## ADJUST IF NEEDED

Make adjustments before placing pattern on fabric.

**TO LENGTHEN:** Cut pattern between lengthen or shorten lines. Spread pattern evenly, the amount needed and tape to paper.

**TO SHORTEN:** At lengthen or shorten lines, make an even pleat taking up amount needed. Tape in place.

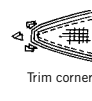
When lengthen or shorten lines are not given, make adjustments at lower edge of pattern.

## Sewing

- SEW garment following **Sewing Directions**.
- PIN or machine-baste seams matching notches.
- STITCH 5/8" (1.5 cm) seams unless otherwise stated.
- PRESS seams open unless otherwise indicated clipping when necessary so seams will lie flat.
- TRIM seams to reduce bulk, as shown below.



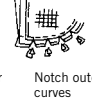
Trim enclosed seams into layers

## General Directions

### Cutting/Marking

#### BEFORE CUTTING:

PRESS pattern pieces with a warm dry iron. PRE-SHRINK fabric by pre-washing washables or steam-pressing non-washables.

CIRCLE your cutting layout.

PIN pattern to fabric as shown in Cutting Layouts.

• FOR DOUBLE THICKNESS: Fold fabric with RIGHT sides together.

• FOR SINGLE THICKNESS: Place fabric RIGHT side up.

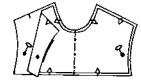
• FOR PILE, SHADED OR ONE WAY DESIGN FABRICS: Use "with nap" layouts

#### AFTER CUTTING:

Transfer markings to WRONG side of fabric before removing pattern. Use pin and chalk method or dressmaker's tracing paper and wheel.

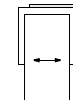
#### To Quick Mark:

- Snip edge of fabric to mark notches, ends of fold lines and center lines.
- Pin mark dots.

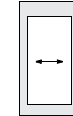


### SPECIAL CUTTING NOTES

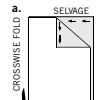
★ If layout shows a piece extending past fold, cut out all pieces except piece that extends.



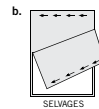
Open out fabric to single thickness. Cut extending piece on RIGHT side of fabric in position shown.



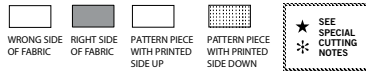
✱ Mark small arrows along both selvages indicating direction of nap or design. Fold fabric crosswise with RIGHT sides together, and cut along fold (a).



Turn one fabric layer around so arrows on both layers go in the same direction. Place RIGHT sides together (b).

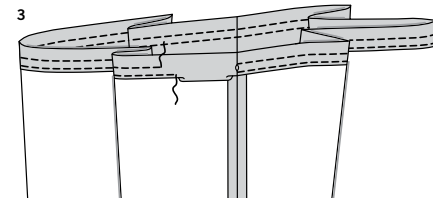
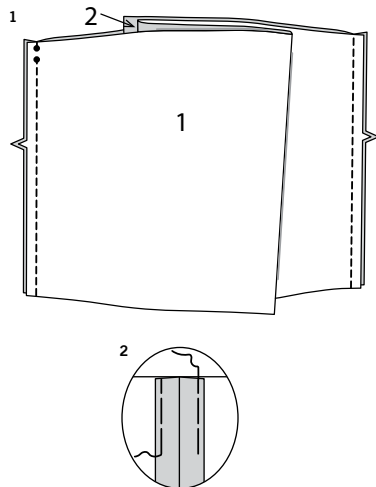
**TOP A, B, C**

**NOTE:** The first view mentioned will be shown, unless otherwise instructed.

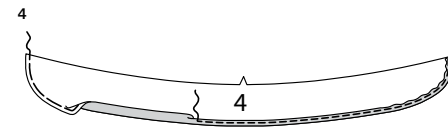
**FRONT AND BACK**

**1.** With **RIGHT** sides together, pin **FRONT** (1) to **BACK** (2) at sides, matching small dots. Stitch, leaving left side seam free between small dots.

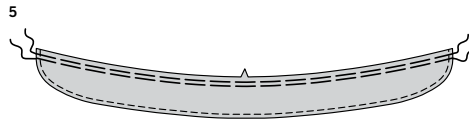
**2.** To keep elastic from getting stuck in the seam allowances as it's inserted, use machine-basting or fusible web to anchor them to top within the casing area. Be sure to remove basting after casing is finished.



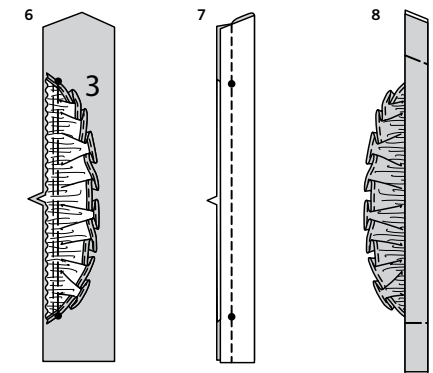
**3.** Press under 1/4" (6mm) on upper edge of top. Press upper edge to **INSIDE** along foldline for casing. Stitch close to lower edge of casing. Stitch again 1/2" (1.3cm) above first stitching.

**SHOULDER STRAPS****VIEW A**

**4.** Stitch 1/4" (6mm) from lower edge of **RUFFLE** (4), using long machine stitches, as shown. Turn up 5/8" (1.5cm) hem at lower edge of ruffle, turning in 1/4" (6mm) on raw edge. Pull thread to ease in fullness. Stitch.



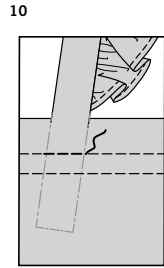
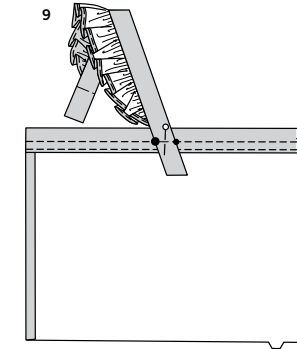
**5. GATHER** marked edge of ruffle.



**6.** With **RIGHT** sides together, pin ruffle to **SHOULDER STRAP** (3), matching notches and dots. Adjust gathers; baste.

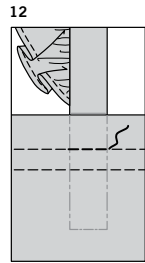
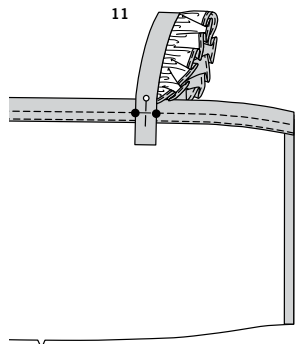
**7.** Fold shoulder strap on foldline, **RIGHT** sides together (over ruffle), matching dots. Stitch long edge, leaving ends open and being careful not to catch finished ruffle edge. Trim seam.

**8.** Turn strap **RIGHT** side out, turning ruffle out; press. Baste raw edges together.



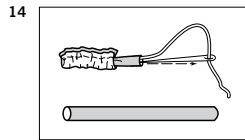
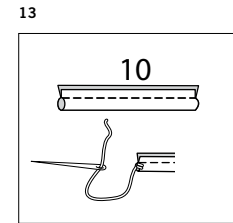
**9.** On WRONG side, pin back end of shoulder straps to upper edge of top back, matching dots and stitching line to upper casing stitching. Baste along stitching line.

**10.** Stitch in place over upper casing stitching.



**11.** On WRONG side, pin front end of shoulder strap to upper edge of top front, matching large dots and stitching line to casing stitching. Baste along stitching line.

**12.** Stitch strap in place over upper casing stitching.

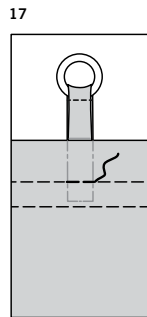
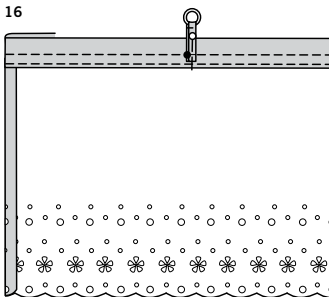


**13.** Fold LOOP (10) in half lengthwise, with RIGHT sides together. Stitch long edges in 3/8"(1cm) seam; trim seam.

**14.** Turn loop RIGHT side out. To turn, fasten a heavy thread securely to one end. Push needle (eye first) through strip; press.

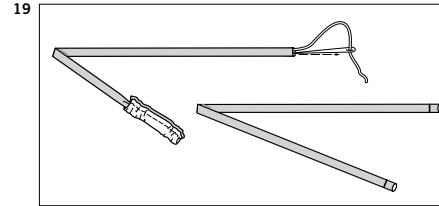
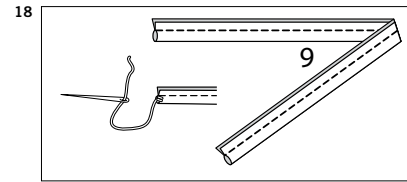


**15.** Slip one end of loop through one ring, folding on foldline, having raw edges even; baste 3/8"(1cm) from raw edges. Stitch loop along stitching line.



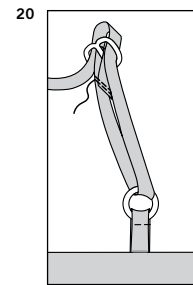
**16.** On WRONG side, pin loops to upper edge of top back, matching small dots.

**17.** Stitch in place over upper casing stitching.



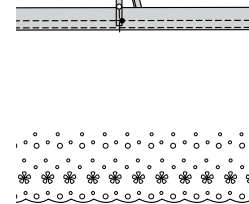
**18.** Fold SHOULDER STRAP (9) in half lengthwise, with RIGHT sides together. Stitch long edges in 3/8"(1cm) seam; trim seam.

**19.** Turn strap right side out. To turn, fasten a heavy thread securely to one end. Push needle (eye first) through strip; press. Baste raw edges.

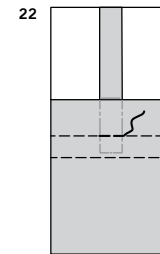


**20.** Thread end of strap through slider and through "O" ring on back loop. Bring end back and slip end through slider again. Fold back end along foldline. Stitch 3/8"(1cm) raw edge, leaving upper strap free to adjust.

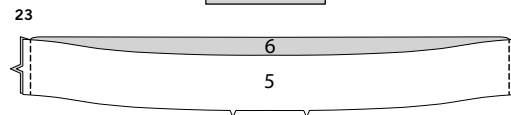
**21.** On WRONG side, pin free or remaining end of shoulder strap to upper edge of top front, matching large dots.



**22.** Stitch strap in place over upper casing stitching.

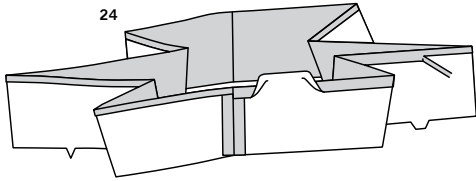

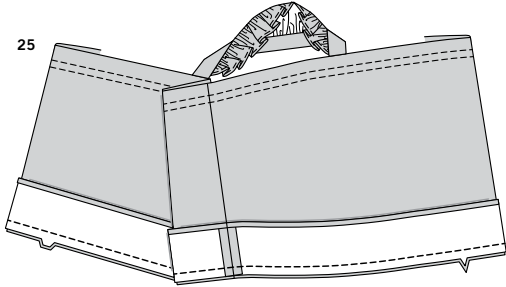
**23.** Stitch LOWER FRONT FACING (5) to LOWER BACK FACING (6) at sides.

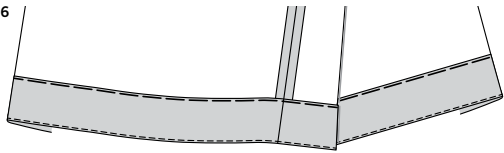
24. Press under 5/8" (1.5cm) on unnotched edge of facing. Trim pressed edge to 3/8" (1cm).

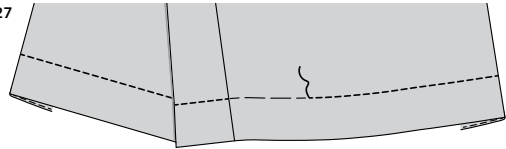
25. With RIGHT sides together, pin facing to lower edge of top, matching centers and seams. Stitch; trim seams. **UNDERSTITCH** facing.

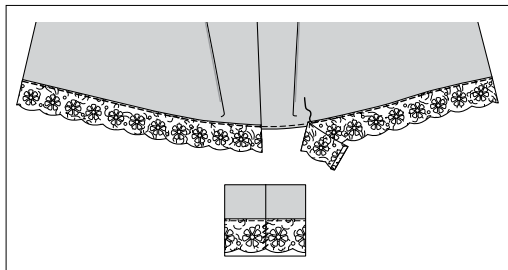
26. Turn facing to inside; press. Baste close to pressed edge, through all thicknesses.

27. On outside, stitch facing close to basted edge.

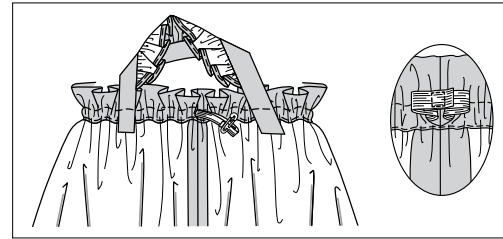

#### HEM AND LACE TRIM C

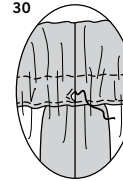
28. Make a 5/8" (1.5cm) **NARROW HEM** on lower edge of top. On outside, pin lace trim to lower edge of top, having straight edge just over hem stitching, turning under and having ends meet at one side seam. Stitch along straight edge of lace. Whip-stitch ends of lace together securely.

29. Cut a piece of elastic using **GUIDE FOR ELASTIC (8)** pattern piece. Insert elastic through opening in casing. Overlap ends and hold with a safety pin. Try on top and adjust to fit. Stitch ends of elastic securely.

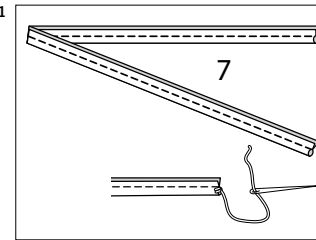


30. **SLIPSTITCH** opening in casing.

**TIP**-To secure elastic so it won't twist in wearing, stitch through all thicknesses of casings in the groove of each seam.

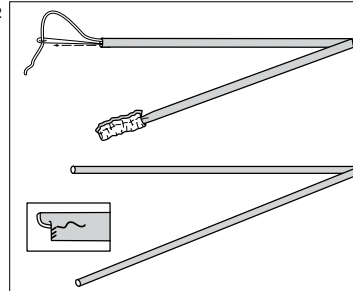
#### BOW TIE A, B

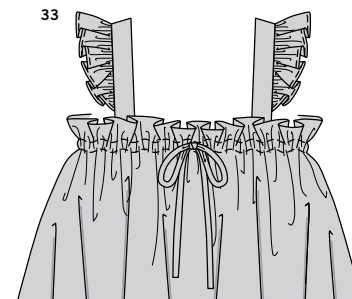
31. Fold **BOW TIE (7)** in half lengthwise, with **RIGHT** sides together. Stitch in 3/8" (1cm) seam, leaving an opening for turning. Trim seams.

32. Turn bow tie **RIGHT** side out. To turn, fasten a heavy thread securely to one end. Push needle (eye first) through strip; press. Tuck in raw edges on ends. **SLIPSTITCH**.

33. Tie bow tie in a bow. Tack bow to bodice front, centering over small dot.
